This guide provides information on all programs and services offered through the Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division, Planning Advocacy and Community Services (PAC) unit for older adults, people with disabilities, and family caregivers.

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# Planning, Advocacy, and Community Services Unit

**Programs and Services** 

The Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division, Planning, Advocacy, and Community Services Unit offers programs and services to older adults, people with disabilities and their caregivers.

#### **ADSD Direct Services**

The following programs are offered at ADSD offices throughout Nevada.

#### **Communication Access Services (CAS)**

Statewide: (702) 830 - 9103

**Description:** The Communication Access Service (CAS) program provides information, assistance, and access to individuals who are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech impaired. In addition to providing administration of the Communication Access Services Centers program, the program offers interpreter services, Relay Nevada, Interpreter Registry, and Interpreter mentoring services.

**Eligibility:** The target population consists of any Nevadans who are deaf, hard of hearing or speech impaired and their families. The programs serve Nevadans of all ages and backgrounds, including late-deafened and older citizens.

#### **Community Advocates**

**Description:** The Community Advocate Program provides information and advocacy services for older adults and people with disabilities. Most often they provide assistance with emergent situations such as eviction, threatened utility cutoffs, and emergency assistance for repairs Services include advocacy services, information and referrals for programs and services, emergency Assistance, public presentations relevant to division programs and services, and education for older adults and family members concerning their rights.

**Eligibility:** Any individual who is aging or has a disability, who does not reside in a facility.

#### Senior and Disability Prescription (SRx/DRx) Program

**Description:** The Senior and Disability Prescription (SRx/DRx) Program provides a subsidy toward the member's Medicare Part D monthly premium for participating Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug Plans.

**Eligibility:** SRx Program: Medicare eligible; Age 62 and older at the date of application; Nevada Resident continuously for 12 months; Adjusted gross annual income no more than \$30,556 for singles and \$40,732 for couples (SFY 21). DRx Program: Medicare eligible; Age 18-61 with a qualifying disability; Nevada Resident continuously for 12 months; Adjusted gross annual income no more than \$30,556 for singles and \$40,732 for couples (SFY 21).

#### Taxi Assistance Program (TAP)

Southern Nevada: (702) 486-3681

\*Clark county only

**Description:** This program provides discounted taxicab fares to qualified individuals, age 60 and older, and persons of any age with a permanent disability through coupon booklets that are accepted by all taxicab companies in Clark County.

**Eligibility:** Nevada residents aged 60 or older or persons of any age that are permanently disabled, with incomes below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.

#### **Community Partner Programs**

In addition to the direct services offered through ADSD offices, the following services are available through community partners.

**Adult Day Care** – Planned care for dependent adults in a supervised, protective, congregate setting during some portion of a day.

**Nevada Care Connection Resource Center** – Information, assistance, and access into long-term support systems for seniors, people with disabilities, caregivers, and those planning for future long-term support needs. The service includes indirect and direct representation of clients, and case management, as needed, to obtain needed services and benefits.

Assistive Technology for Independent Living Program –Services to support individuals with disabilities to live in their community versus an institutional setting. The program can provide assistance to individuals to identify their Independent Living goals and the appropriate Assistive Technology (AT) that is needed for the individual to care for themselves or receive care in their homes and their community.

**Communication Access Services Center** – Provides communication access to Nevadan's who are deaf, hard of hearing or who are speech impaired. Specific services include use of specialized telecommunications equipment to access the phone system; advocacy services; information and referral; distribution of assistive technology; and language acquisition and mentoring.

**Evidence-Based Services** – Health promotion and disease prevention interventions that educate participants about their health conditions, how to manage them, and/or ways to adopt healthy behaviors to enhance their overall quality of life. These evidence-based programs provide education and tools which empower older adults to manage their health, thereby reducing health care utilization and costs associated with their health condition.

**Family Caregiver Support** – A cluster of services funded under Title III-E of the Older Americans Act, intended specifically for informal caregivers of any age who care for adults age 60 and older, and/or grandparents or other relatives, age 55 or older, caring for a child, age 18 or younger.

**Food Pantry** – Provides food items to older individuals on a monthly basis.

**Geriatric Health and Wellness:** *Assessment and Care Management* – Evaluations of eligible clients' medical and social issues and concerns, focusing on the improvement of physical and/or social functioning and reducing disability. *Education* - Education and training in geriatric health issues, techniques and/or trends to promote maintaining good health practices for people age 60 and over, with emphasis on minority individuals and those living in rural areas.

**Medication Management** – Education, evaluation, and consultation to eligible clients regarding their prescription and over-the-counter medications and supplements to reduce instances of mismanagement, drug interactions, and other events that may cause adverse health conditions and unnecessary hospitalizations.

**Home Safety, Modification and Repair** – Home safety evaluations, home safety training, home modifications/installations of assistive technology, home maintenance and/or home repair services to persons, age 60 and older, who are at risk for injury and/or decreased ability to remain in their residences.

**Homemaker** – Assistance provided to persons having difficulty with general cleaning, shopping for groceries and prescriptions, picking up mail and other essential household tasks.

**Legal Assistance** – *Legal advice, counseling and/or representation* by an attorney or other person acting under the supervision of an attorney. Also funded is Legal *Ward Representation*, which provides assistance, consultation, and representation in legal matters to maintain rights and improve the quality of life of older persons who are being considered by the court for guardianship or under guardianship.

**Medicare Assistance Program** – this program provides assistance to Medicare beneficiaries including counseling and education, promoting awareness of Medicare fraud, abuse, and prevention.

**Meals, Congregate and Home-Delivered** – Meals provided to eligible individuals in a congregate setting or delivered to individuals who are homebound due to illness, disability, or geographic isolation, which prohibits them from eating in a congregate setting.

**Nevada Assistive Technology Collaborative (NATC)** – provide both State Level Activities and State Leadership Activities which will support the Assistive Technology (AT) Act. These include State finance systems (financial lending and state funded AT), AT device reutilization, device demonstrations, device loans, training, technical assistance, public awareness, and information and assistance.

**Personal Emergency Response System (PERS)**— This program enables individuals to summon assistance in an emergency by pressing the alert button on a personal *transmitter* (worn on the wrist or around the neck). The transmitter alerts a monitoring station that assistance is needed. Another service housed within PERS is a computer-assisted or volunteer *telephone reassurance* program that contacts clients via their personal telephone, on a set schedule, to ensure that they are safe, to remind them to complete certain tasks, take medication, prepare for appointments, or meet needs as defined by the provider in a care plan prepared with the client and/or his/her representative.

**Representative Payee** – Money management and supportive case management for eligible individuals, age 60 and over, who are unable to receive and manage their own funds and have no other suitable person to act on their behalf.

**Respite Care** – A non-medical service provided to a client by a respite worker to allow the in-home primary caregiver the opportunity to perform other responsibilities. This service may also use vouchers to purchase respite care.

**Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)** – A participant-centered program designed to provide and promote useful work training experience opportunities for economically

disadvantaged persons age 55 or older and to facilitate the transition of job-ready participants into unsubsidized employment in public organizations and private-sector businesses and industries.

**Senior Companion** – Provides companionship activities for a client in his or her home. The companion may also accompany the client and provide transportation to access services outside of the home.

**Transportation** – Provides safe transportation for access to services such as: nutrition, medical services, social services, adult day care, shopping, and socialization.

#### Eligibility Criteria

Generally speaking, all services have an age 60 or older limitation. The exception to this is:

- Nevada Care Connection Resource Center (any age with a disability)
- Medicare Assistance Program (Medicare beneficiaries or potential Medicare beneficiaries of any age)
- Assistive Technology for Independent Living (any age with a disability)
- Communication Access Services Center (any person who is deaf, hard of hearing, or speech impaired)
- Family Caregiver Support (family or informal caregivers, age 18 or older, who care for individuals age 60 or older)
- Respite Care (caregivers of individuals living with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders regardless of age; For grandparent respite: relative caregivers (not parents) age 55 or older who care for children under age 18; relative caregivers (including parents) who care for adults with disabilities age 18-59)

In addition, the following services have specific criteria:

- Congregate meals spouse of eligible individual, person with a disability who lives with an eligible individual or meal program volunteer.
- Home-Delivered meals homebound due to illness, disability, or geographic isolation, and unable to attend a congregate meal site. Spouse of eligible individual or person with disability who lives with eligible individual.
