AB 223	15-566	Assem. O'Neill	Revises provisions governing crimes against older persons and vulnerable persons. Passed Senate Judiciary
AB 242	40-417	Leg. Comm on Sr. Citizens, etc.	Revises provisions relating to facilities for skilled nursing. Amended to an interim study bill. Sen. Ops/Elections
AB 253	24-1125	Assem. Com on Ops/Elections	Requires proof of ID to vote. Exempt. Assembly Ways & Means
AB 266	919	Assem. Dickman	Requires proof of identity for voting. Exempt. Assembly Ways & Means
AB 272	40-759	Assem. Hickey	Revises provisions governing the opportunities for certain businesses that provide referral services to residential facilities to operate in Nevada.
AB 289	693	Assem. Araujo	Provides for centralized regional mental health services and information. Exempt. Assembly Ops/Elections
AB 292	54-606	Assem. Oscarson	Enacts the Nevada TeleHealth Access Equity Act Passed Senate Commerce/Labor
AB 293	168	Assem. Oscarson	Revises provisions governing public administrators. Senate Govt. Affairs
AB 294	692	Assem. Thompson	Enacts provisions to address suicide prevention for Nevada's veterans.
AB 310	769	Assem. P. Anderson	Provides for flexibility and efficiency in Nevada's Medicaid program. Assembly Ways & Means

AB 481	42-1168	Dept. Admin	Provides additional authority for enforcement of laws prohibiting deceptive trade practices. Exempt. Assembly Commerce/Labor
SB 6	40-63	Leg. Comm on Health Care	Provides for the regulation of patient-centered medical homes. Passed Assembly Commerce/Labor
SB 7	39-64	Leg. Comm on Health Care	Revises provisions governing involuntary admission to certain facilities of persons believed to have mental illness. Assembly HHS
SB 35	39-330	DPBH	Provides processes for cooperation with other states for proper and expeditious treatment of persons with mental illness or intellectual disabilities in institutional care settings. Assembly HHS
SB 68	54-290	Comm on Commerce, Labor & Energy	Provides for issuance of limited licenses to practice medicine in Nevada to physicians who are licensed in another jurisdiction. Assembly Commerce/Labor
SB 70	19-155	Atty General	Revises provisions governing meetings of public bodies. Assembly Govt. Affairs
SB 165	53-135	Sen. Segerblom	Creates a domestic workers bill of rights.
SB 177	512	Sen. Comm. on HHS	Enacts the Caregiver Advise, Record, Enable (CARE) Act. Signed by Governor
SB 196	84	Sen. Comm on HHS	Revises provisions relating to licensing of medical professionals. Enrolled. Going to Governor
SB 198	830	Sen. Kieckhefer	Revises provisions relating to Medicaid.
SB 210	40-1132	Sen. Finance	Revises provisions relating to inspections of certain medical facilities and offices. Exempt. Senate HHS
SB 259	1035	Sen. Woodhouse	Provides education and training for health care professionals concerning certain diseases prevalent in older adults.
SB 262	643	Sen. Harris	Revises provisions relating to guardians. Assembly Judiciary

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SB 269	1035	Sen. Woodhouse	Establishes an interim study committee to research issues regarding the behavioral health and cognitive care of older persons. Exempt. Senate Ops/Elections
SB 284	974	Sen. Minority Ldr.	Revises Nevada’s State Plan for Medicaid to provide for certain non-medical transportation. Exempt. Senate Finance
SB 336	40- 32	Sen. Parks	Revises provisions relating to options for end-of-life care.
SB 384	279	Sen. Kieckhefer	Revises provisions relating to trusts and estates. Assembly Commerce/Labor
SB 422	38- 1159	Dept. Admin	Revises list of preferred prescription drugs used for Medicaid Program. Exempt. Senate Finance
SCR 2	237	Sen. Hardy	Encourages education of medical care providers and first responders regarding caring for people with Alzheimer’s disease. Assembly HHS
