SCSEP State Plan Public Comment

**Comment/Question 1.** What is the age requirement?

**Response:** An individual must be 55 years of age or older. However SCSEP has residency, income requirements and enrollment priorities, which are:

Priority individuals –

- Individuals 65 and older and/ or
- Has a Disability
- Has Limited English proficiency or low literacy skills
- Resides in rural area
- Is a veteran or spouse of a veteran
- Has low employment prospects
- Has failed to find employment through WIA Title I services
- Is homeless or at risk of homelessness

In Addition:

- Meets the eligibility requirements related to age for, but does not receive benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act (42 U.S. C. 401 et seq.)
- Has a severe disability

**Comment/Question 2.** Are the priorities listed in the plan?

**Response:** Yes, in section 9.

**Comment/Question 3.** What benefits does a participant receive?

**Response:** Individuals have the option of receiving a free physical, which results cannot be used to determine eligibility; items needed at their training or job site and up to 60 days of unpaid approved break. Results of physicals are not given to the SCSEP staff.

**Comment/Question 4.** This is a challenging program/grant to manage.

**Response:** It can be.

**Comment/Question 5.** Can a healthcare agency be a host site agency?

**Response:** Yes, in fact the University Medical Center and Valley Hospital are current a host site agencies.

**Comment/Question 6.** Have people dropped off due to the economy?

**Response:** No. Demand for the program is greater than ever. Many people 55 years and older have lost their jobs or become homeless as a result of the current economy.

**Comment/Question 7.** Is there a program that subsidizes the employer for taking on a SCSEP employee?

**Response:** On the job experience (OJE) is available through the national SCSEP grant (AARP Foundation) now. As mentioned in the State Plan, Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) has submitted a request to Department of Labor (DOL) for approval of OJE for state SCSEP positions.

**Comment/Question 8.** Are there restrictions as to the type of training or employment?

**Response:** Enrollees go through an assessment process to determine the type of interest, ability and skills they possess before placement into subsidized training. The skills they learn at their host site agency determine the type of jobs that they apply for employment.

**Comment/Question 9.** Why do you continue outreach if there is a waitlist?

**Response:** The waitlist helps us to track eligible individuals and support funding request to the Department of Labor. Outreach helps to make eligible individuals, host agencies and employers aware of the program.

**Comment/Question 10.** Can one sign up for 25 participants?

**Response:** That is a common question. The agency must be a 501 (c) 3 or a public agency to become a host site agency. The number of participants available for placement with host sites is limited by funding and actual training positions that are justified.

**Comment/Question 11.** How can a person who is homeless get training?

**Response:** The individual has to be helped through supportive services, e.g. mailboxes at homeless shelters, clothing, bus passes, etc...

**Comment/Question 12.** My agency has worked with both Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada and AARP Foundation for many years training individuals. It has been a very valuable program from us and for the individuals that participate.

I've gone through the draft several times and I think it looks good.  
Just a couple points of clarification:

Section 8. Supporting Employment Opportunities for Participants - 4th paragraph We encourage all participants to work their full available hours on a consistent basis. Based on participant need, we will work with them on any needed exceptions.

Sections 10. Community Service Needs - 4th paragraph In order to expand employment opportunities for SCSEP participants in Nevada, plans for training expansion are underway. AARP Foundation has established an MOU relationship with Boyd Gaming and will be exploring the job market demand for commercial drivers in Nevada, which would evidence a need for commercial driver license training in Nevada. They are working to add more community service sites for Protective Services to fill security guard job openings. In addition, AARP Foundation will begin working closely with the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce Networking Events to assist with recruitment and potential job openings.
