NEVADA BOARD OF APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS LICENSE EXEMPTION WAIVER

The Declaration of Emergency Directive 011, issued by the Governor of the State of Nevada, allows licensees who currently hold a valid license in good standing in another state, licenses which currently stand suspended for licensing fee delinquencies or failure to meet continuing medical education requirements, or have retired from their practice in any state with their license in good standing may temporarily practice within the State of Nevada. *THIS WAIVER DOES NOT APPLY TO LICENSES WHICH HAVE BEEN REVOKED OR VOLUNTARILY SURRENDERED AS A RESULT OF DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS.*

By signing this waiver:

You have read and understand the governor's <u>Emergency Directive 011</u> and understand the practice of applied behavior analysis without a license is permitted until 60 days after the termination of said directive.

You have read and understand the written statement: <u>Exemption to Practice Applied Behavior</u> <u>Analysis (ABA) in the State of Nevada</u> provided by the Board of Applied Behavior Analysis and affirm, under penalty of perjury, that all of the information supplied herein is to the best of your knowledge true, accurate, and complete and that you have not withheld, misrepresented, or falsely stated any information required by the Board of Applied Behavior Analysis as condition to practice within the State of Nevada without a license.

Furthermore, upon termination of Emergency Directive 011, you understand there will be a 60day grace period, after which, this waiver will longer be valid in which services may no longer be rendered without a valid Nevada license and proof that all services have ceased may be requested.
