Linking Instructional Needs and Key Supports (LINKS Team)



Department Overview

The LINKS Team promotes collaboration among parents, students, and educators to ensure students and their families have the necessary services available for success and provides direct services, classroom consultation, professional learning, and supplemental program for Autism classrooms. (Guide to Student Services, 2020-2021)

Focused Support Overview

Autism

Support teachers through Professional Learning (PL) sessions and consulting with teachers on a referral basis to address individual or whole class needs.

ARL/ARC

Direct support, coaching, modeling, and mentoring for Alternative Route to Licensure (ARL) and Certification (ARC) teachers

SB-IIS

School-Based Intensive Intervention Services (SB-IIS) are a short term supplementary service to increase "learning to learn" behaviors as designated in a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP)

Connection Center

Families engage in specific training to address their child's behavioral goals in everyday living situations.

6 weeks of lesson plans in English Language Arts (ELA), Math, Social/ Emotional (SEL)
