REOPENING MODELS

- The district offers 3 models for students returning to school:
 - In-person
 - Hybrid
 - Distance learning
- All special education students' families have the option to choose to attend school every school day.
- All district special education teachers received additional professional learning support on implementing IEPs through all 3 reopening models, in-person, hybrid and distance Learning

SPECIALLY DESIGNED INSTRUCTION

 Educational activities will address all specially designed instruction identified through the IEP process and will be provided in conjunction with general education programming, whether in-person, hybrid, or distance learning models.

SELF CONTAINED PROGRAMING

 For students receiving special education services through self-contained programs, such as Comprehensive Life Skills and Strategies, who choose to attend school on a hybrid model or participate in distance learning, the curriculum has been adapted to be delivered via distance learning and educators have been trained in this instructional model.

RELATED SERVICE

• Related services are provided within the in-person, hybrid and distance models. Families that selected the distance model do have the option for related services to be provided in-person.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR SUPPORTS

Special Education Return to Classroom Guidance

Work with families to prepare students for social distancing, wearing a face mask or shield before school started

Hand washing, wearing a face mask/shield and social distancing supports within the class environment and school task analysis pictures, photos within visual schedules, pre teaching, social stories/ narratives, video modeling, specific verbal praise and providing tokens and/or points
