- Research

- System Strengths
- Challenges that must be addressed
- Critical issues that need to be resolved

Develop a **Plan** with specific strategies related to enhancing the service system for people living with ASD throughout Nevada.

- What you would like to see as areas for focus and action in the next 5 years?





# Vision, Mission and Guiding Principles

The Commission is crafting their vision, mission and guiding principles to act as a framework of how they operate. We are asking for your feedback to finalize these foundational concepts.



# Vision, Mission and Guiding Principles

Please complete the worksheets provided. The following definitions are provided to help you complete the request.

**Vision:** The vision statement is a vivid description of what kind of future the organization is trying to create. In other words, it is a clear and compelling goal that serves to unify an organization's efforts.

**Mission:** The mission defines the fundamental purpose for the organization to exist. Together, the mission and values show what people in the organization believe in, giving meaning to the work necessary to make the organization flourish.

**Guiding Principles:** Guiding Principles, also called Core Values, shape and influence the actions of a group. Guiding principles are those principles and beliefs that are held dear and which shape how people think and act within the organization. Guiding Principles can ***act as a compass*** to keep a group on course.
