One of the goals in the Autism Commission five year strategic plan is to create a website. The Workforce Development Subcommittee would like to propose the following concept for the Commission to consider.

Monkey Logic, a Nevada-based software development company, has offered to assist with this objective at no charge. Monkey Logic has offered to develop, design, host, and manage a website for the Commission which lists providers of applied behavior analysis therapy for individuals with autism spectrum disorders in the state of Nevada. The website would include a searchable database of providers with specific information on each including, but not limited to, location, service area, wait list times, and which insurance plans each provider accepts. ABA providers will have the ability to update their profile. Website visitors will be able to review and comment on specific providers. Comments and reviews will be moderated. Overall, this platform will operate similar to the way that Yelp operates for other business reviews and information.

The Workforce Development Subcommittee recommends to the Autism Commission that the Commission approve and support this concept and approve the offer of Monkey Logic.
