## Become a Registered Behavior Technician!

### What is it?

- Autism therapists work with children, teens, and families living with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD).
- They learn Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) to teach new skills, make new connections, and help turn challenging behavior around.
- ABA is the science of understanding behavior in order to change that behavior through specific interventions. Working with people with ASD is exciting, demanding, and rewarding!

### What are the requirements?

- Therapists earn a national credential to become a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) by completing a 40-hour training through an approved provider.
- Pass a background check.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Hold a high school diploma or higher.
- Successfully pass the competency assessment.
