Structure:

2 session one week apart to maximize opportunity to participate for public – stakeholders – elected – agency staff

One hour each – could be same time OR one early morning – other late afternoon to maximize availability to attend.

Limit to 3 issues that WILL be heard in Legislature:

Home and Community Based Services Funding – maintain or increase to meet caseload growth

Caregiver/Employee Flexibility of Earned Sick Leave

Order of Protection or Vulnerable Persons

Moderator to welcome and introduce speakers
