

The Nevada COVID-19 Aging Network (Nevada CAN) rapid response effort is a statewide, interorganizational collaboration of many aging services organizations, led by the Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD).





OBJECTIVES



- Provide credible information and resource availability.
- Utilize student and community volunteers to connect with elders via phone or internet-based technology to:
 - Check on basic, medical, and social service needs
 - Engage them in meaningful social interaction
- Assess for individual needs for basic essentials, including:
 - Food, medication, pet food, medical supplies, etc.
- Connect county senior service agencies and non-profit organizations with volunteers to fulfill individual needs through home delivery of essential items
- Deliver essential clinical services via telehealth, including:
 - Social work, primary care, geriatric assessment, and psychiatric care
