## DASHBOARD DEVELOPMENT

**Dashboards** provide at-a-glance views of key performance indicators in relation to goals and objectives of the NvSILC. A “dashboard” is a simple formative “progress report” that provides information about where an organization is and where it is in real-time. The goal is to provide the NvSILC members and the Nevada public with ongoing indicators that can be viewed at anytime.

A dashboard is only useful when it provides the information to inform the user that key aspects of operations are working and where they are in relation to goals. Also, a dashboard informs the user when key aspects are failing or need additional attention. Too much information can be just as distracting as insufficient information. A data dashboard must be simple and understandable with agreement on what is critical.

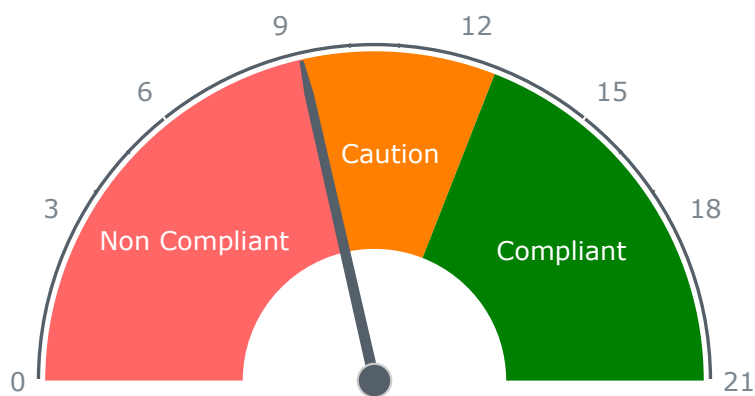
