Recommendation #17 Community Outreach

<u>Current Recommendation as Stated</u>: Encourage the business community to establish and implement employee assistance programs and dementia-friendly activities that encompass education and training for employees including those who are caregivers. Specifically, foster partnerships with other organizations that are also affected by Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia, such as diabetes, stroke, and heart organizations, to help promote information about services and care for those who have symptoms of dementia.

<u>Determination</u>: Do you propose that for the 2021 State Plan this recommendation be:

- 1) Retained as is
- 2) Retired to the Appendix (it has been accomplished or is no longer relevant)
- 3) Revised / Updated

<u>Justification</u>: We want them to have the capacity to assist employees with issues related to dementia. Though we cannot force employees/businesses to implement assistance programs, we can try to motivate them by describing how dementia training can help enhance relationships with both their customers and employees. Better language would be to provide free training about dementia similar to Dementia Friendly Southern Nevada (Urban) Community Awareness Training and Dementia Friendly America's Dementia Friends.

- o Promote education regarding brain health initiatives
- o Develop partnerships with statewide Dementia Friendly Community Action Groups
