**Project Goals**

- **Goal 1: Develop screening for early identification of Alzheimer's or Dementia and their family care provider.**
- **Goal 2: Connect individuals living with ADRD and their caregivers to appropriate program and service modalities based on consumer needs and person centered approaches. (i.e., implementation of BRI Care Consultation, and other program expansion planned).**
- **Goal 3: Establish and improve datasets to quantify measurable outcomes and expand program evaluation to inform program improvements.**

**Role of the Task Force on Alzheimer's Disease**

Nevada's Task Force on Alzheimer's Disease will work with ADSD to identify needed system developments and training for a Dementia Capable System and serve as a guide for implementing the Nevada State Plan on Alzheimer's Disease and the coordination with this project's work plan. The data collected in this program and the outcome measures will be used to determine the future service for persons with dementia in Nevada. The outcome information will be used by ADSD as well as made available to the Commission on Aging and the Task Force on Alzheimer's Disease.

The increased number of resources, programs, and professionals included in the division provides a great opportunity to develop a comprehensive program for persons with dementia and their families. The creation of the Task Force on Alzheimer's Disease also provides a timely opportunity to build on this program and shape the service delivery of persons with dementia and their families.

***Specific Actions***

- Provide suggestions in developing a screening tool for Alzheimer's or Dementia and their family care provider.
- Provide information and action to improve advocacy, identify and assist with program direction, and integrate system developments.
- Provide information and action in the identification of deficiencies related to existing evidence-based interventions in Nevada, community needs, targeted resources to enhance and modify long term care service paradigms, and necessary and replicable training requirements.
- Provide information and action in the development of a community needs analysis to help identify what services are available and what service needs exist in the state.
- Provide information and action with the development of a sub-site utilizing existing and new information in the resource center to help caregivers and consumers more easily access information and services. Assist to help increase the number of listings for consumers with Alzheimer's or Dementia in the resource directory.
