Conduct Community Needs Analysis to identify existing services as well as service needs in the state. 3. Develop a screening tool to triage and refer individuals to maximize effective use of existing services. 4. Build a website for people with dementia/Alzheimer’s and their family caregivers to learn about services available and engage in their community. 5. Implement BRI Care Consultation to support family caregivers of people with dementia. 6. Develop the EPIC program in Nevada 7. Establish and improve datasets to quantify program outcomes. Increase early engagement of individuals living with dementia and their caregivers. 3.
