- a. Refer to a primary care physician (or the geropsychiatric physician that works with EPS)?

- b. Make a report of concern to the department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)?

- c. Work with the family to coordinate transportation?

- d. Refer to RTC Access bus service?

- e. Refer to Lend-a-Hand, RSVP, Visiting Angels, or another agency that provides transportation?

4) Do you have any recommendations for improving how your agency or other agencies in Nevada (DMV, law enforcement, health care providers, etc.) address concerns regarding the driving safety of older adults with dementia?

5) How confident do you feel in addressing concerns about impaired driving in persons with dementia? Have you found that there is a clear course of action you can initiate when you have concerns about the driving safety of an older adult with dementia?
