STATE OF NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES DIVISION Request for Proposal (RFP)

The Aging and Disability Services Division announces the availability of approximately \$8 Million from a combination of funds from the Fund for a Healthy Nevada (Tobacco Settlement), State General Fund and the federal Older Americans Act. The Purpose of this funding is to support critical supportive service programs in Nevada, which assist older individuals age 60 and older to live independently in their homes. Special emphasis is placed on serving older individuals who are: low income and minority or Native American; limited in English proficiency; at risk of institutional placement; at the greatest economic or social need; and/or, depending on the service provided, persons with disabilities needing assistance to remain independent.

Funds will be committed for a one-year period (7-01-15 through 06-30-16). Consideration for second year funding is contingent upon grantees meeting or exceeding goals and objectives and funding availability. All nonprofits, public agencies and for-profit businesses can apply.
