STATE OF NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES DIVISION Request for Proposal (RFP)

The Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) is announcing the availability of approximately \$5.7M from Older Americans Act and State funds to support nutrition services for people age 60 and older living in Nevada. Nutrition services provide balanced meals and nutrition education to older individuals in congregate settings, such as senior centers, or by home-delivery to older individuals who are homebound due to illness, disability or geographic isolation. Services are targeted to eligible individuals in greatest social and economic need with particular attention to low income individuals, minority individuals, those in rural communities, those with limited English proficiency and those at risk of institutional care. Public, nonprofit and for-profit businesses may apply.

Funds will be committed for a one-year period (10-01-17 through 9-30-18). Consideration for second year funding is contingent upon grantees meeting or exceeding goals and objectives, and funding availability. All nonprofits, public agencies and for-profit businesses can apply.
