The state of Nevada is launching the statewide CAS Mentorship Program!

Who? All interpreters in Nevada who are currently registered with the Nevada Interpreter/CART Registry at any classification.

What? The State's Mentorship Program follows a unique approach by teaching self-analysis skills allowing interpreters to continue developing their skills after they complete their mentorship.

Where? Everywhere in the State. Mentoring is primarily done online using GoReact.

When? Applications are now being accepted to start mentoring this Fall. (Get your application in by July 30 to be considered for the Fall start)

Why? Mentorships are tailored to the individual needs of the mentee to improve their interpreting knowledge and skill.
