3. Discuss upcoming changes related to implementation of SB 286

Jennifer Frischmann stated SB 286 has now been codified onto Chapter NRS 437. Aging and Disability Services Division is working with the Board of Psychological Examiners to ensure a smooth transition. A mailer will be sent out to remind everyone their licenses will expire and urge them to renew before the expiration date of December 31<sup>st</sup>, since there will be no grace period during the transition. A new budget

account will be created October 10<sup>th</sup> for payments that will be received for license renewals. Information pertaining the transition will be on the ADSD website by the end of August.

Jennifer confirmed the Board cannot be created before January 1<sup>st</sup>, but people can apply before then, three applications have already been received. There will be a link for the paper application on the ADSD website, since online applications cannot be accepted at this time.

Jennifer confirmed it is not possible for RBTs to be registered by 1/1/19, since there is currently no process to do this until the board is in place and they establish the process and fees, that may be required.

Ken MacAleese pointed out there are other laws that will delay the process for RBTs to be registered, for example, public workshops need to be conducted before fees can be established.

Jennifer stated the fees that will be collected will be used to fund the board and cover the costs ADSD will have to run the licensing. The board is required to meet yearly as stated in the NRS, but the current board meets monthly.

Morgan Gleich confirmed the Board of Psychological Examiners will renew the licenses expiring this year following the same rules, regulations, waivers and educational requirements that are currently established, the only difference being, payment will need to be made out to ADSD. The last exam by the BPE will be held on December 10<sup>th</sup>, the last board meeting will be held on December 14<sup>th</sup> and transfer period is expected to be between December 21-28.

Jennifer stated Certified Behavioral Interventionist is a new category and the process and requirements for this certification will have to be decided by the new board.

Jennifer asked for assistance in reminding colleagues regarding license renewal by the deadline of December 31<sup>st</sup>, since there will be no grace period. ADSD is hoping for a smooth and transparent transition.
