This presentation shows the outcomes reported on referrals, caseload, waitlist, and program type by the Autism Treatment Assistance Program (ATAP) which are current through August 31, 2024.



# ATAP Caseload

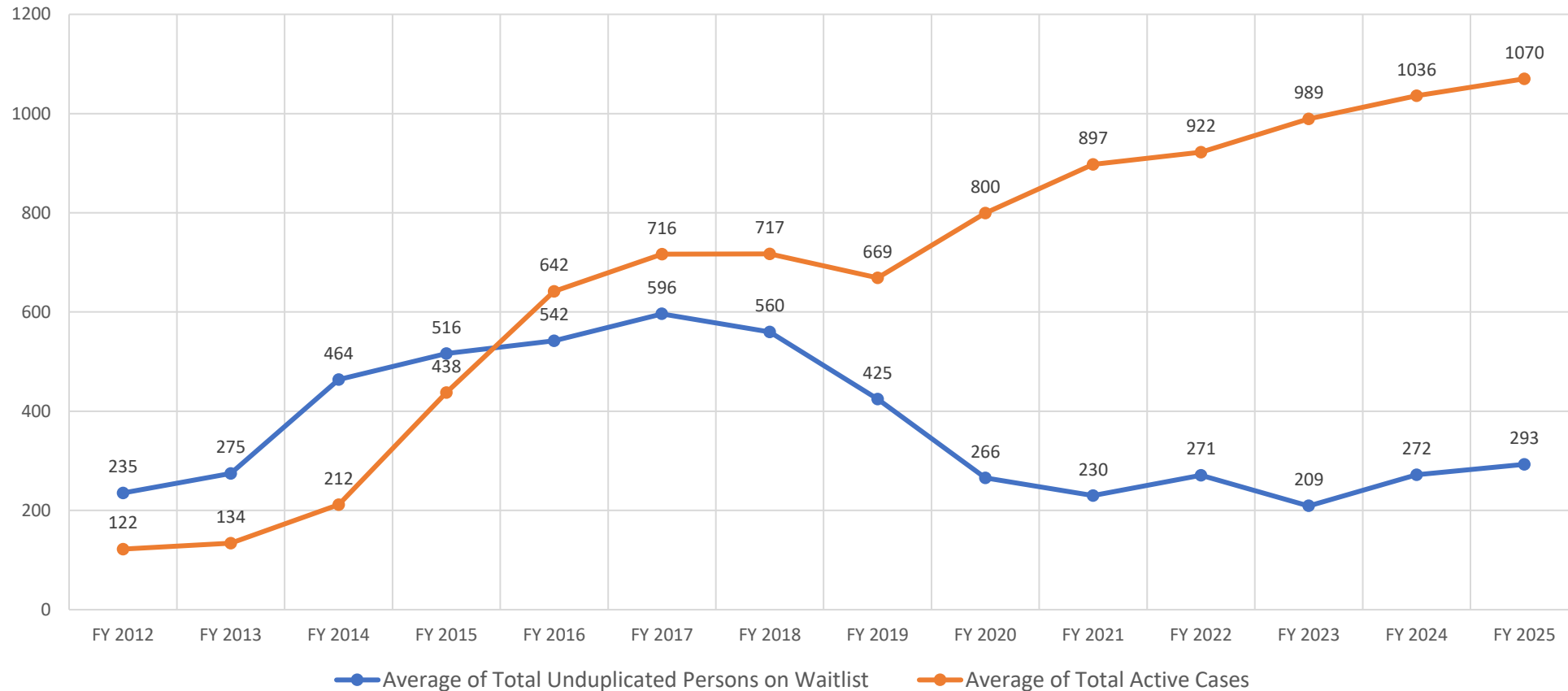
## Monthly caseload for August 2024

- 113 new applications
- 1,072 active children
  - Average age of 8.7 years old
- 48 total inactive children
  - Average age of 6.1 years old
    - 38 Straight ATAP
    - 10 Service Coordination
- Average wait time for all ATAP children (*days from application start date to the date the child drops or becomes active*):
  - 50 Days

ATAP Caseload: FY2012 - FY2025 (Year To Date)

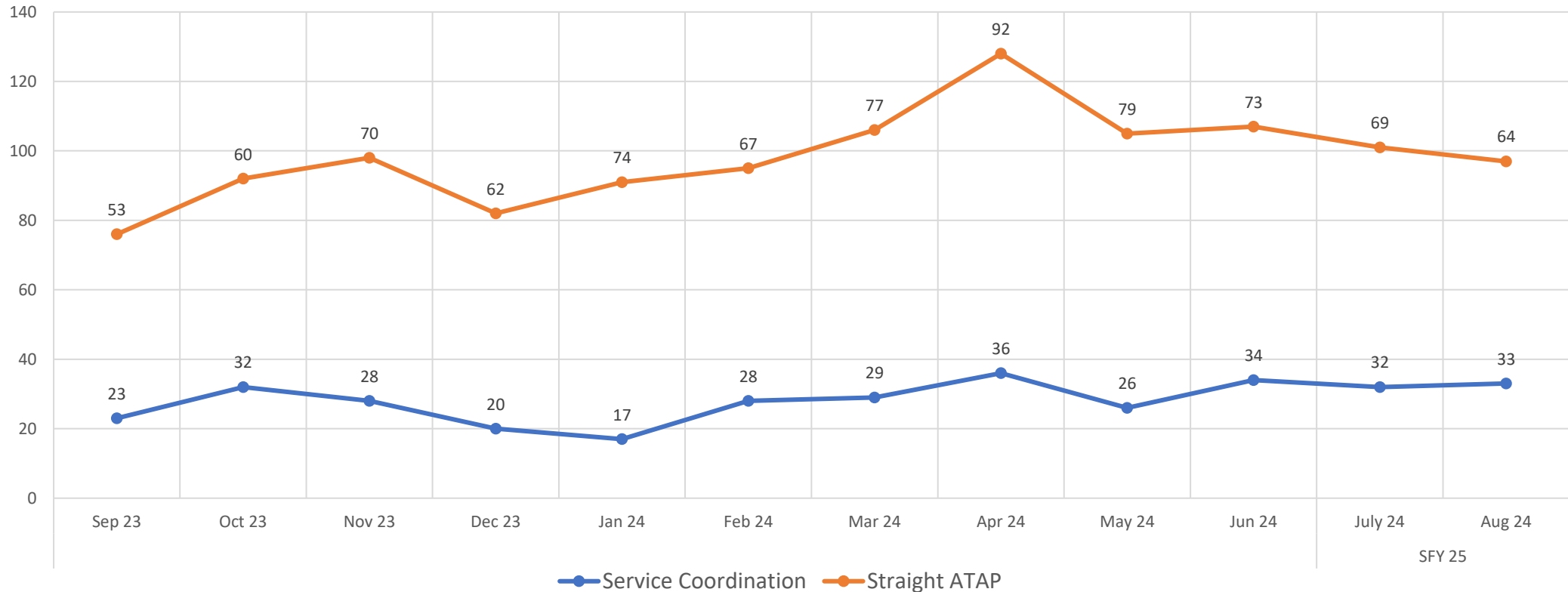


This graph shows the Active caseload and Waitlist averages over time. These numbers were derived from the CLEO report and include children in “Referral” status.

ATAP Waitlist: September 2023 - August 2024

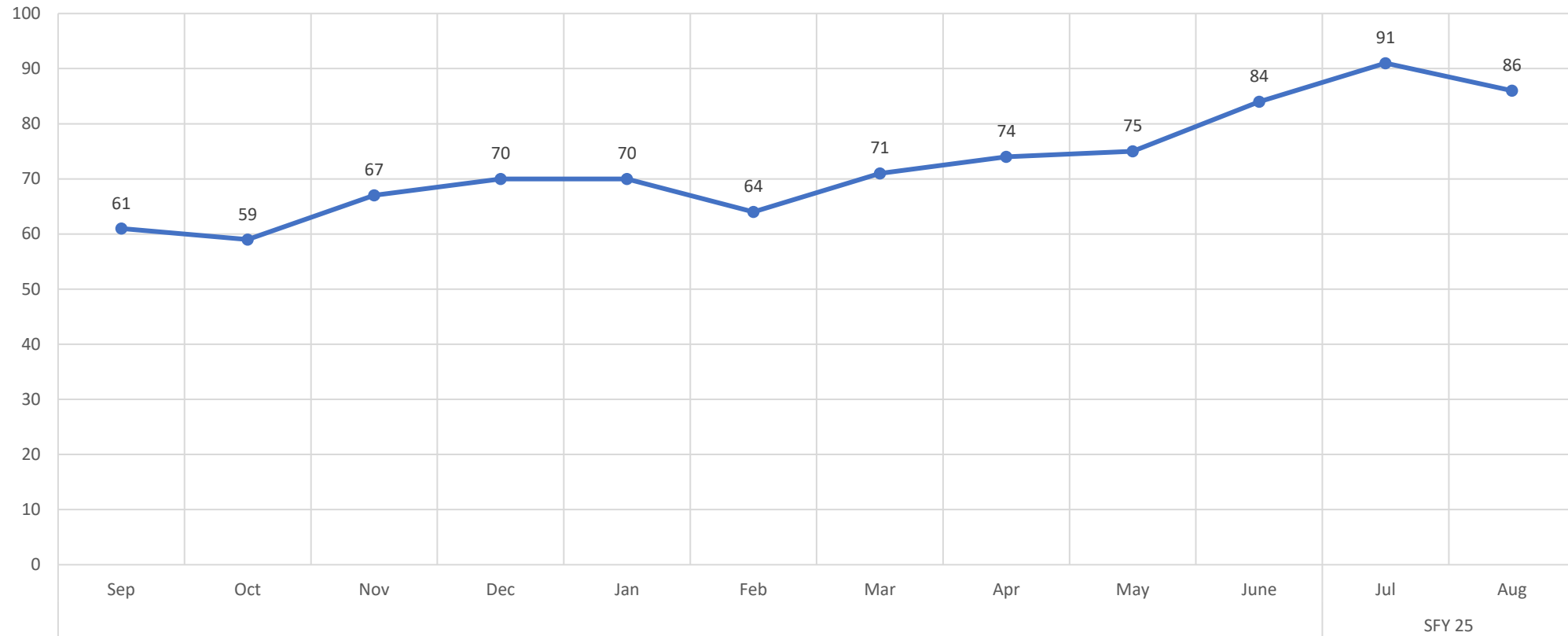


This graph shows the monthly Waitlist Straight ATAP and Service Coordination caseload amounts over the last 12 months.

Average Total Wait Time in Days - Straight ATAP: September 2023 - August 2024



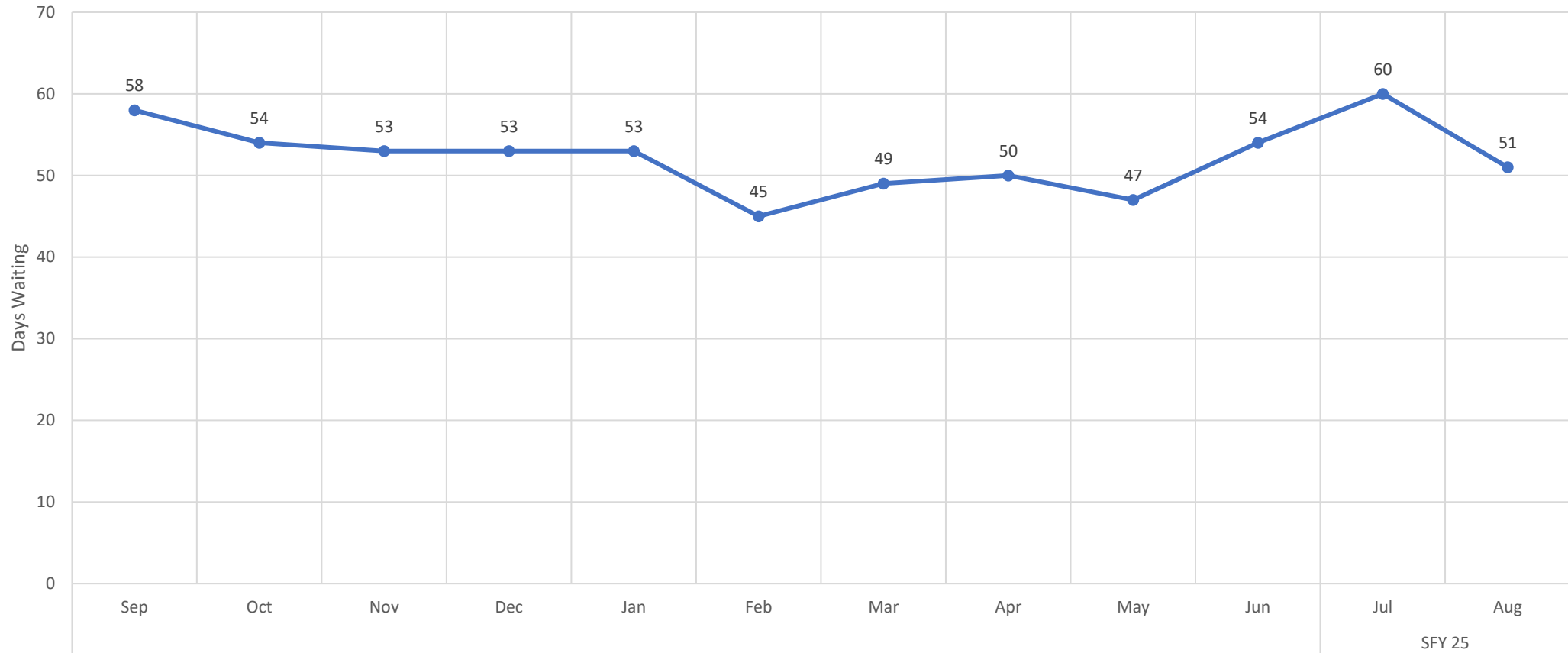

Average Wait Time (Referral to Eligible) in Days - Straight ATAP: September 2023 - August 2024



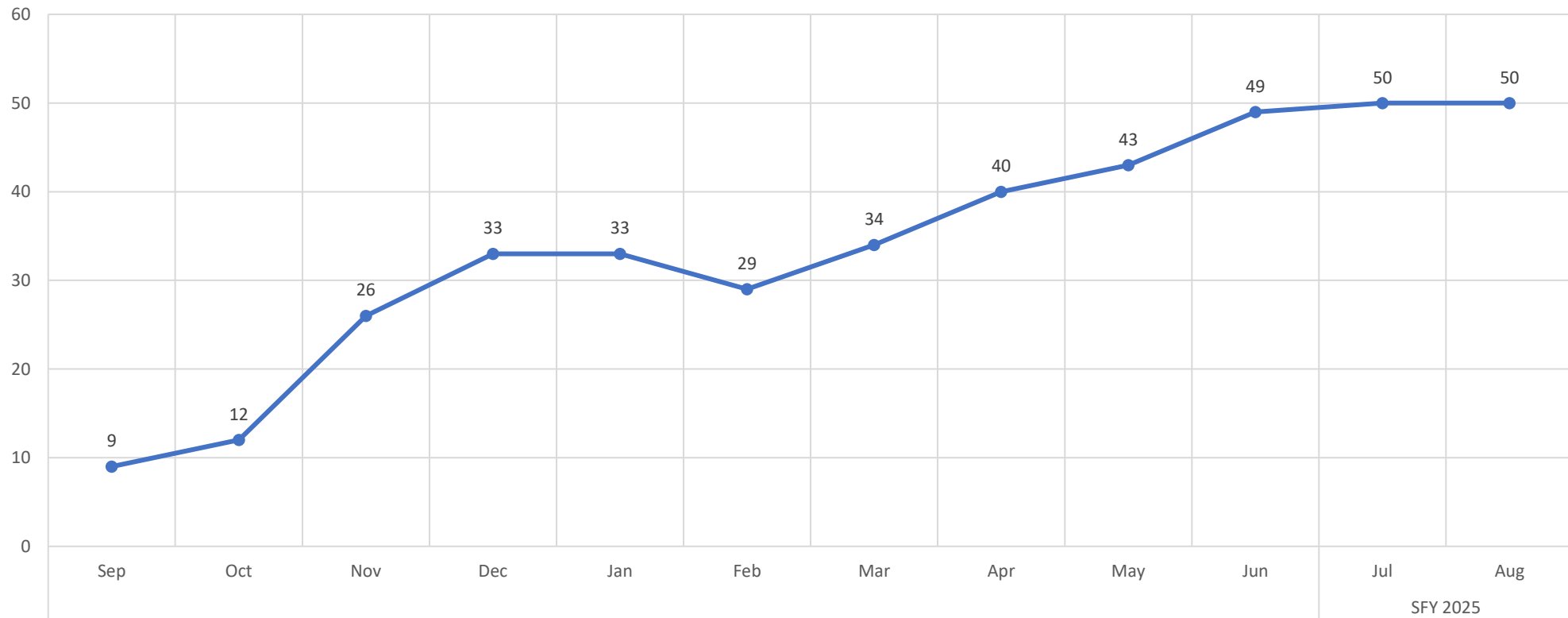

*\*This average includes time spent from “Pending” start date until “Active” or “Dropped” status date*

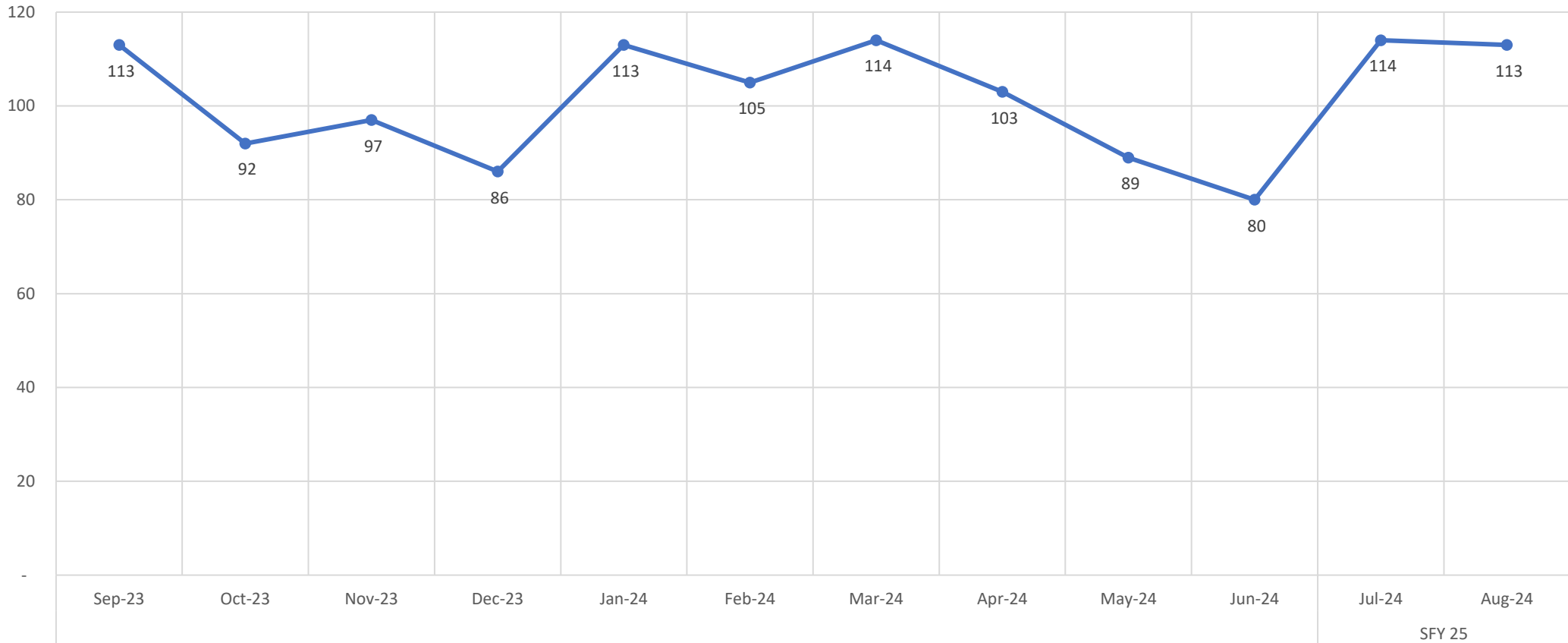

New Referrals: September 2023 - August 2024

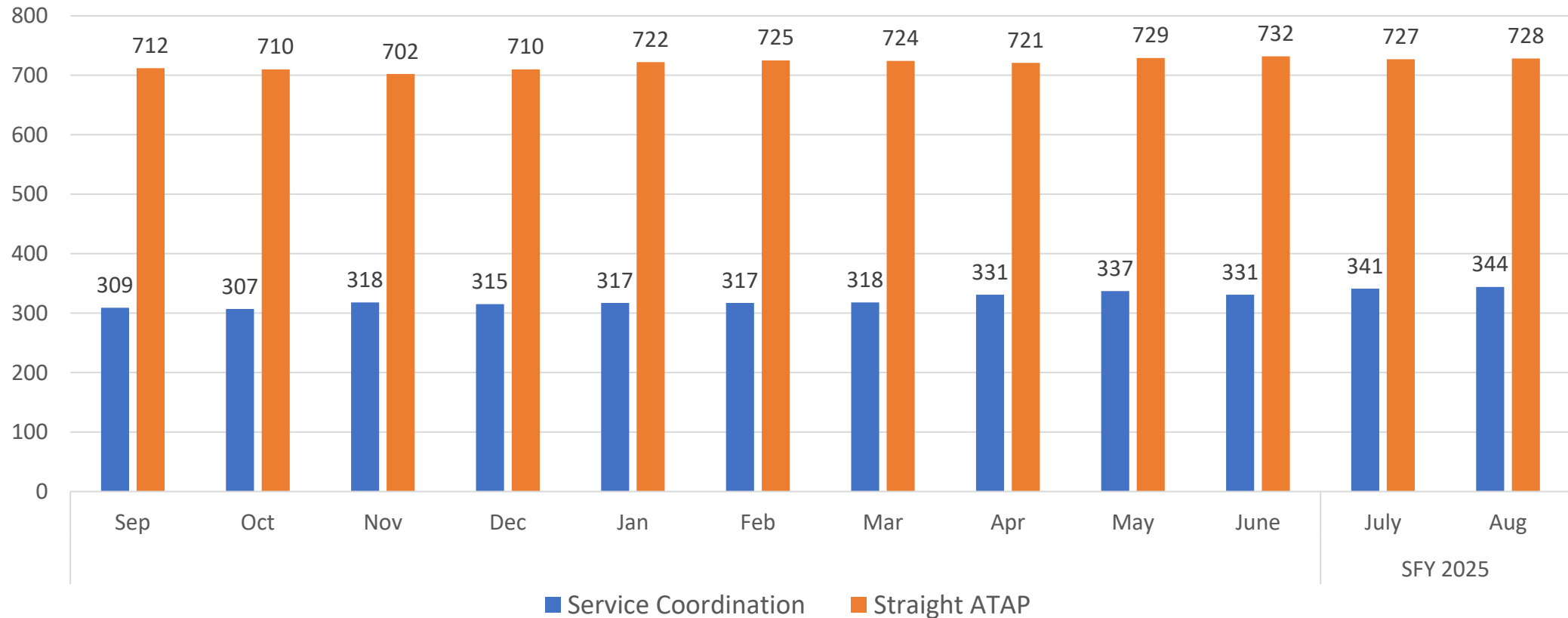


This graph shows the monthly number of New Referrals entering the ATAP system over the last 12 months.

Straight ATAP & Service Coordination: September 2023 - August 2024

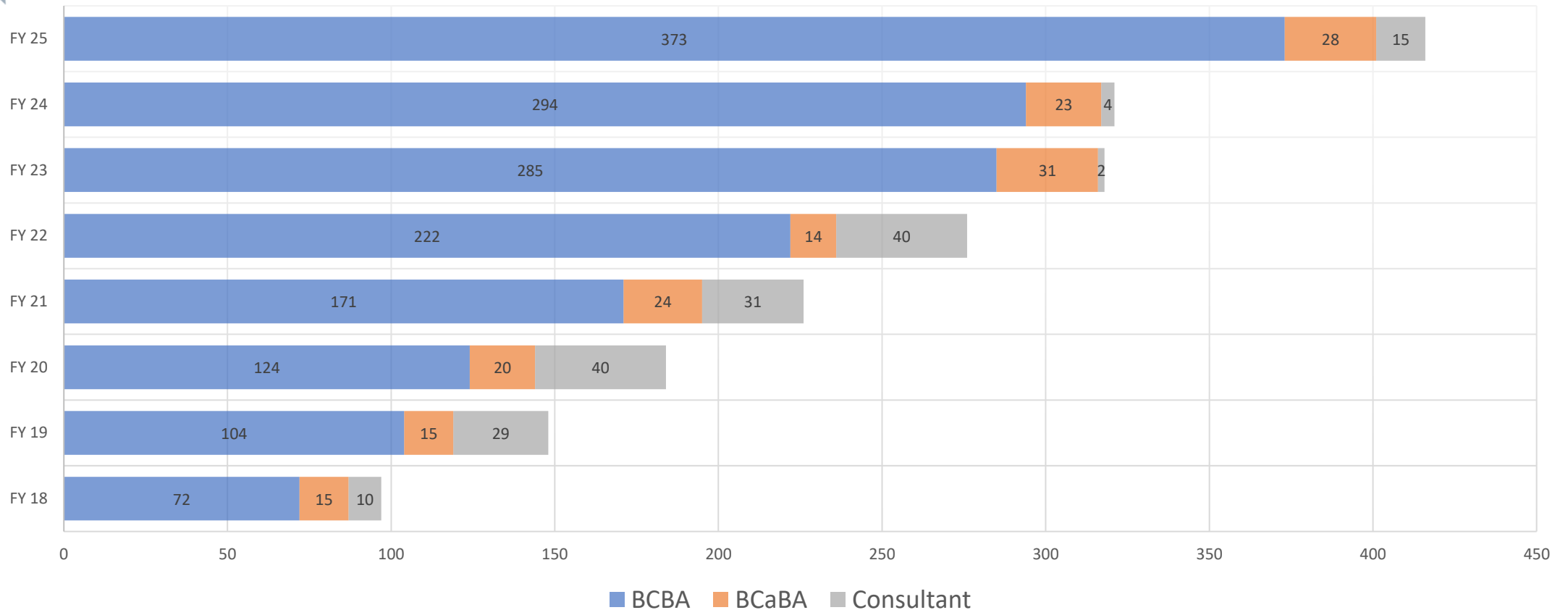


This graph compares Straight ATAP and Medicaid (Service Coordination) Active caseloads over the last 12 months.

Trend In Professional Service Providers: FY18 - YTD

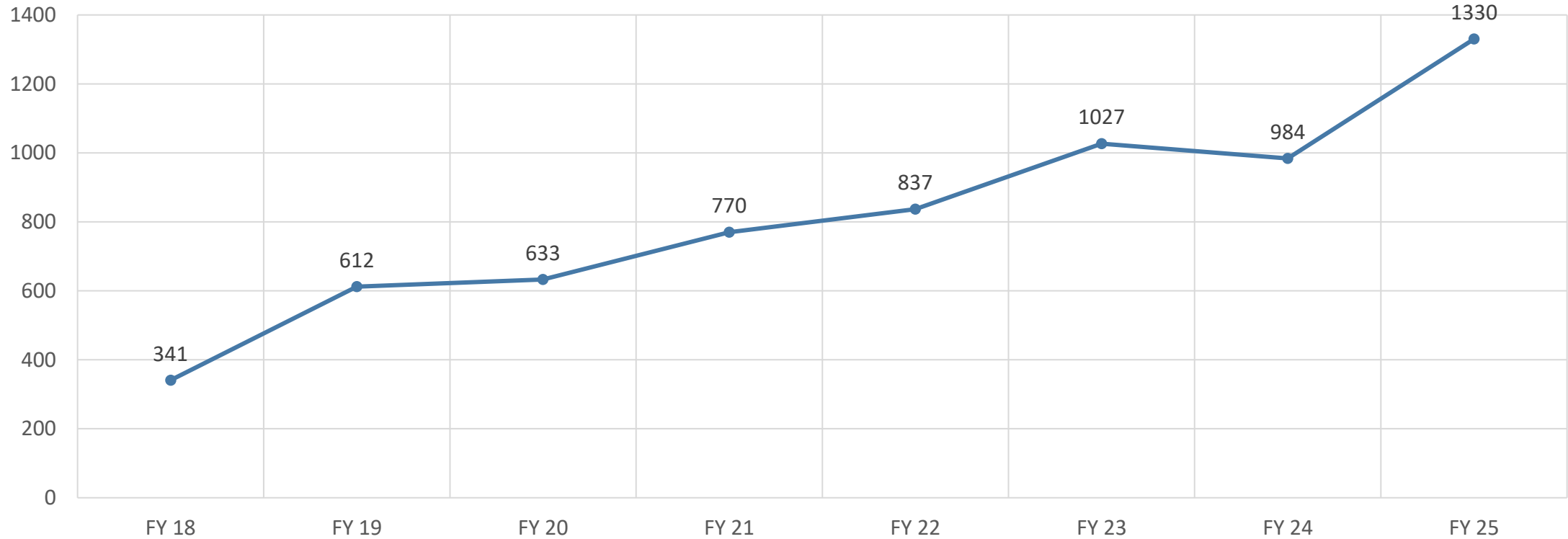


This graph shows the growth of professional service providers at the BCBA level from FY18 through YTD.
