SB 380/BDR 118: Seeks to provide law enforcement training concerning ASD. Authorizes a certified registered behavior analyst, applying for registration as a registered behavior technician, to engage in the supervised practice of applied behavior analysis under certain conditions. -

SB78: Revises Provisions Relating to Boards, Commissions, Councils and Similar Bodies.

SB140/BDR 62: Expands the jurisdiction of certain specialty courts for juveniles to include children with fetal alcohol syndrome and other neurodevelopmental disorders.

SB174/BDR53: Requires School Districts to Coordinate with Certain Providers of Services for Enrolled Pupils with Autism Who Have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

SB 257/BDR 106: Seeks to provide better diagnostic criteria for ASD.

AB6 Establishes the Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Treatment Assistance Program within the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services.

AB586 Makes supplemental appropriations to the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services for an unanticipated shortfall related to costs associated with certain provider payments.

SB8 Revises provisions relating to services provided by the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services.

SB396 Makes various changes relating to education.
