Required Trainings

NRS 449

- Trainings to recognize and prevent abuse of older persons
- Regulations requiring training relating specifically to cultural competency
- Requirements for certain employees of an agency to provide personal care services in the home, community or another organization
 - Successful completion of training related to basic emergency care of a person in cardiac arrest, or
 - Successful completion of training related to the use and administration in first aid including cardiopulmonary resuscitation



Required Trainings cont.

- NAC 449
 - Qualifications and trainings of caregivers
 - Special Diets and Diabetes require specific training
 - First aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation
 - Bowel and bladder care
 - Administration of medication
 - Alzheimer's care; requires an endorsement
 - Maintenance of personnel files
 - Attendants required knowledge and training

Training Platforms used cont.

- In house training offered by a licensed Registered Nursing Assistant
 - Includes CPR, how to appropriately transfer clients, using a Hoyer lift, basics of continence care.
 - Some trainings are offered to their PCA's in a group setting so they can all complete it at once time.
 - Any trainings not offered in house are required to be found by the PCA on an independent basis
- In house training offered by Administrator or other staff
 - Provider sent me the document of what they offered for the initial 16hour training and the 8-hour annual training required thereafter
 - 16-hour training includes coverage related to all required areas per the NRS and NAC. This training includes a 382-page handout which has quizzes and tests, reading material, Medicaid Service Manual references, NAC/NRS references, and is accompanied by videos.
 - 8-hour training includes the same format as the 16-hour training but is 490 pages including more quizzes and tests annual refresher course for all areas required by the NRS/NAC.
