- Personal Assistance Services program
- Older American Act funding
- Independent Living Grants/ Funds for a Healthy Nevada


#### **Other Options**

## FHN – Independent Living Grants

 NRS 439.630 allows for ADSD's allocation of Fund for Healthy Nevada dollars to be used to provide respite services to any individual with Alzheimer's or other dementia.





## **Traditional Models**

- Voucher Systems
  - Provider agencies
- Volunteer Based
- Self-Directed Vouchers
  - Choice and control
- Cost Sharing/Sliding
   Fee Scale
  - Income vs. Need consideration
  - State Examples





## Respite - Challenges

- Complexity of Individual Needs
  - Level of Care Need
- Caregiver Knowledge of Respite
  - Recognizing the need
  - Accepting respite
  - Scheduling regular breaks
- Availability of respite
  - Gap between public programs and private pay
  - Workforce Training

- Evidence Based Programs
  - Cost to implement and sustain
  - Staff Turnover
  - Program Fidelity
- Funding
  - Older American Act limitations
  - One time vouchers
