September 30, 2023.



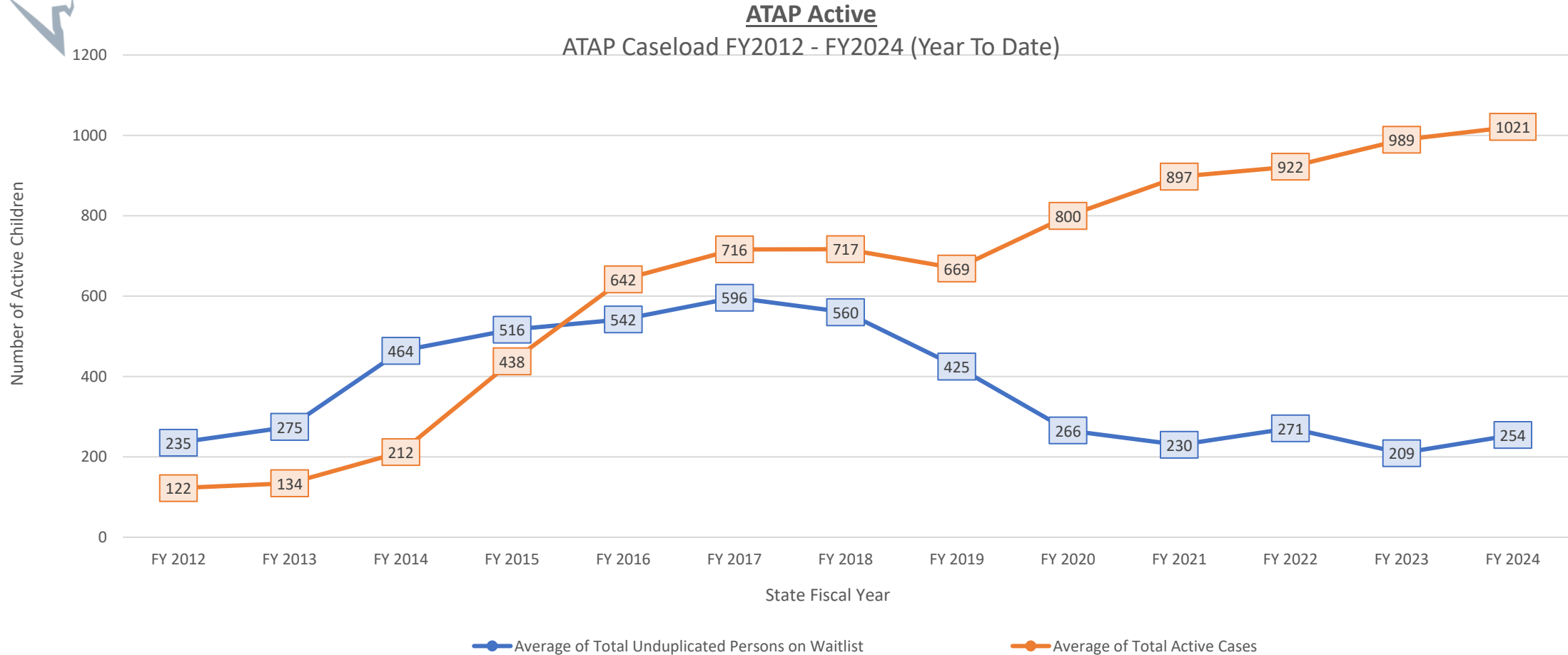
ATAP Caseload

Monthly caseload for September 2023

- 113 new applications
- 1021 active children, average age: 8.6 years old
- 7 total inactive children:
 - 6 Straight ATAP – Average age of 6.6 years old
 - 1 Service Coordination
- Average wait time for all ATAP children (*days from application start date to the date the child drops or becomes active*):
 - 39 Days



ATAP Caseload Growth



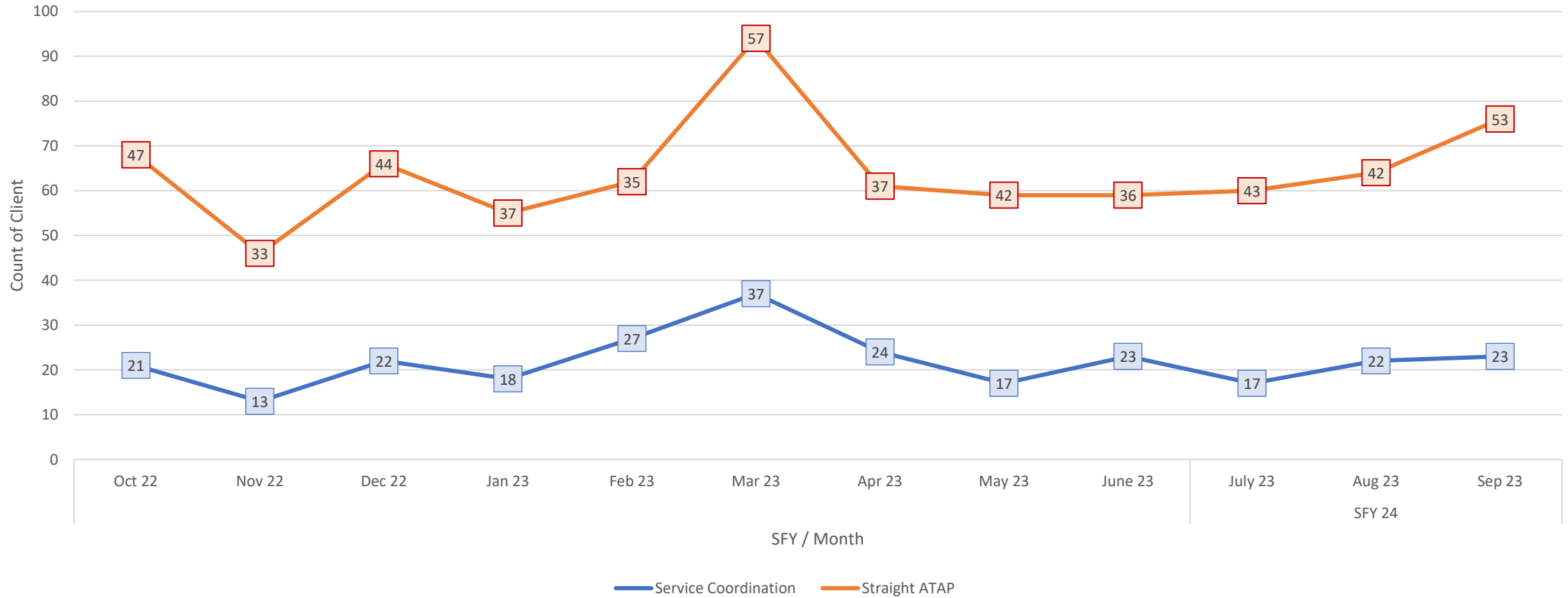
The chart above demonstrates the active caseload and waitlist averages over time. These numbers are derived from the CLEO report.

October 2022 - September 2023



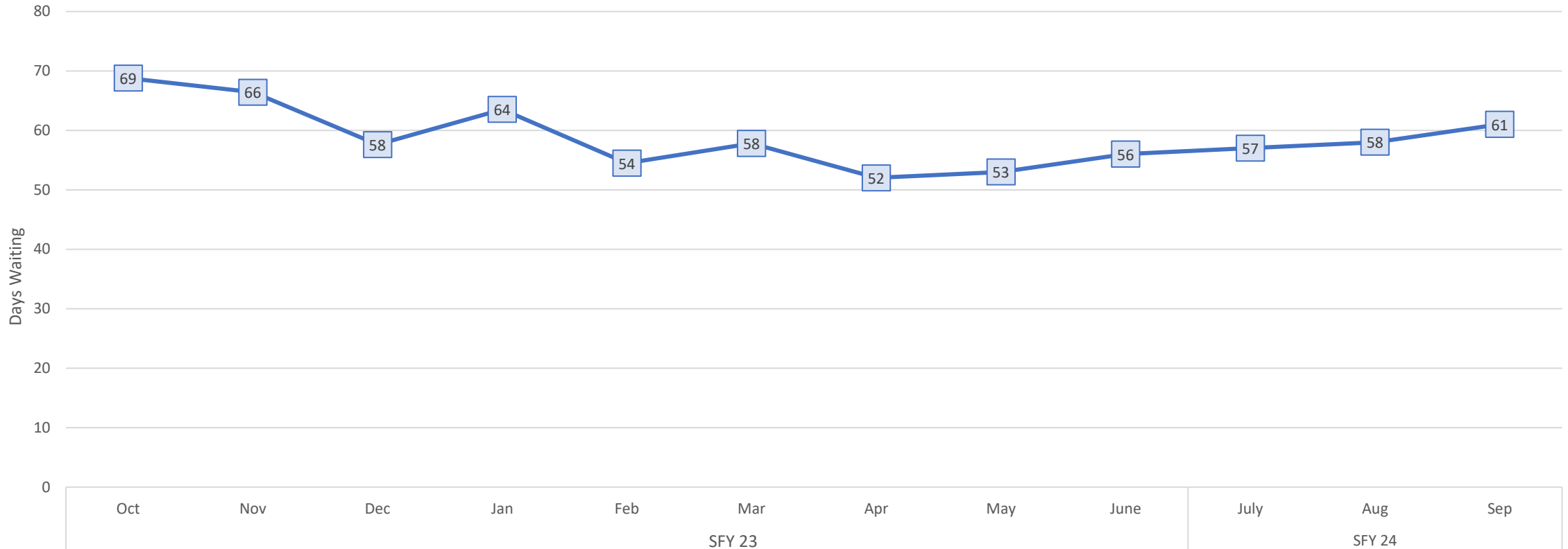
The graph above shows the monthly waitlist as occurred from October 2022 through September 2023.

**Wait time average includes all time child spent from application start date until they were either Dropped or went Active.*

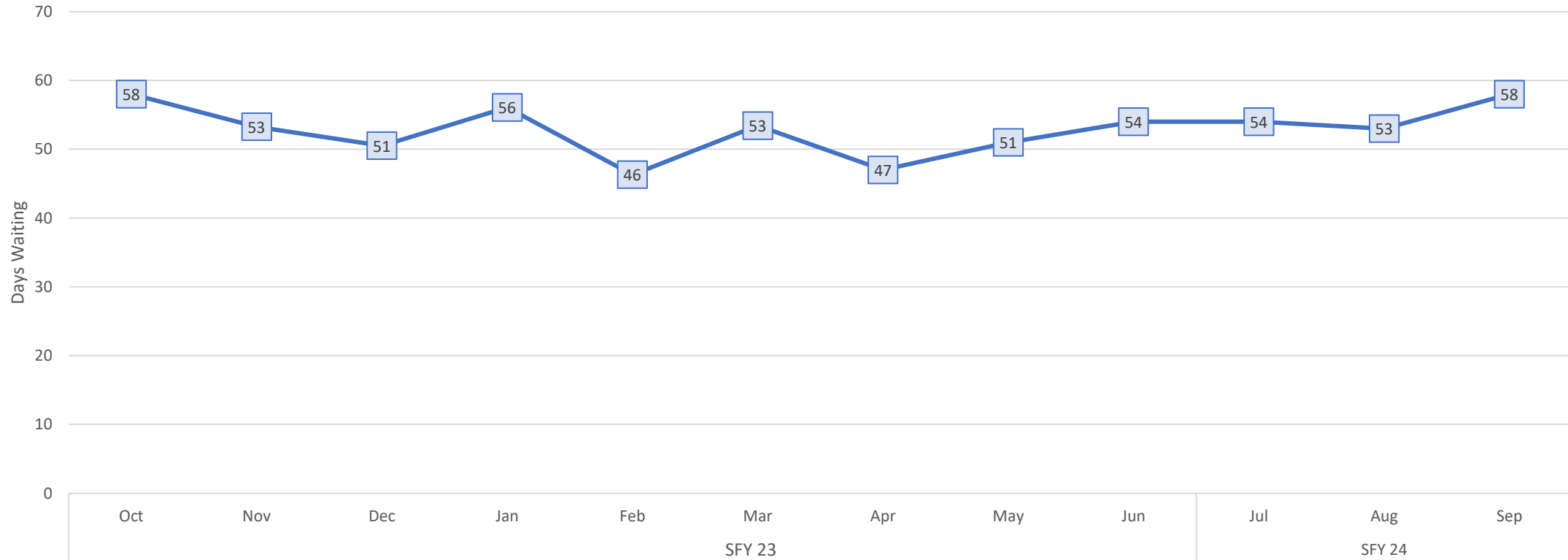

**Wait time average includes all time child spent from application start date until they were deemed Eligible..*

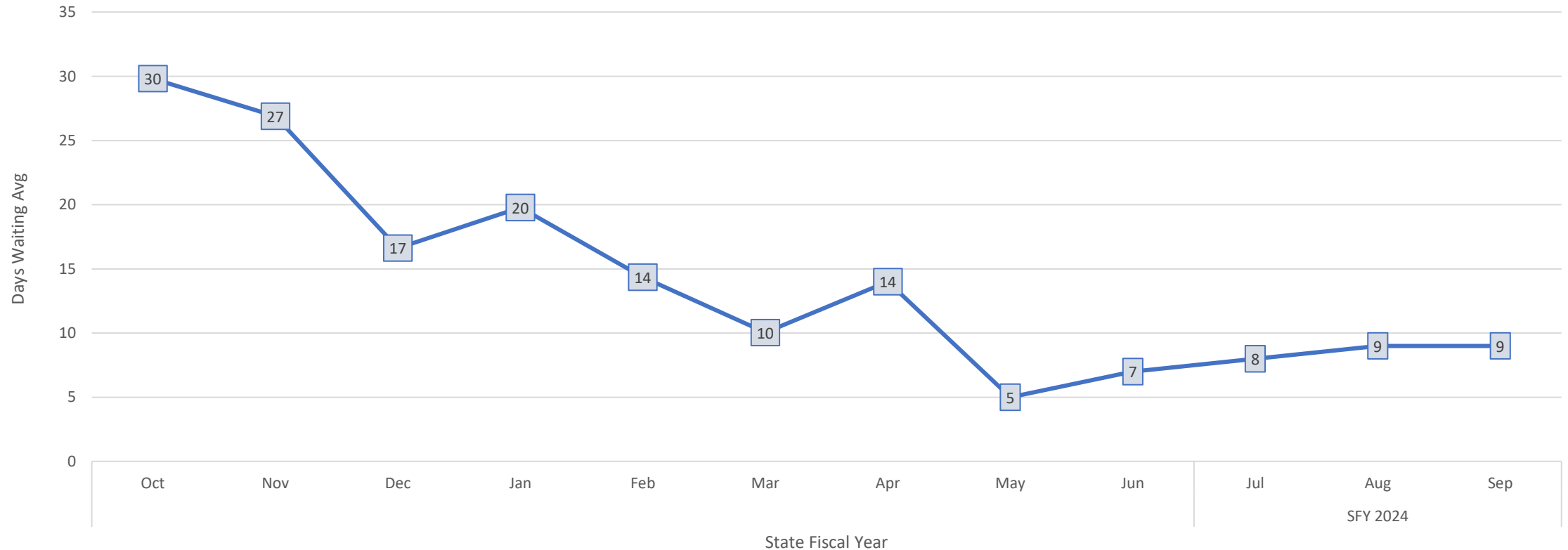

**Wait time average includes all time child spent from Pending start date until they were either Dropped or went Active.*

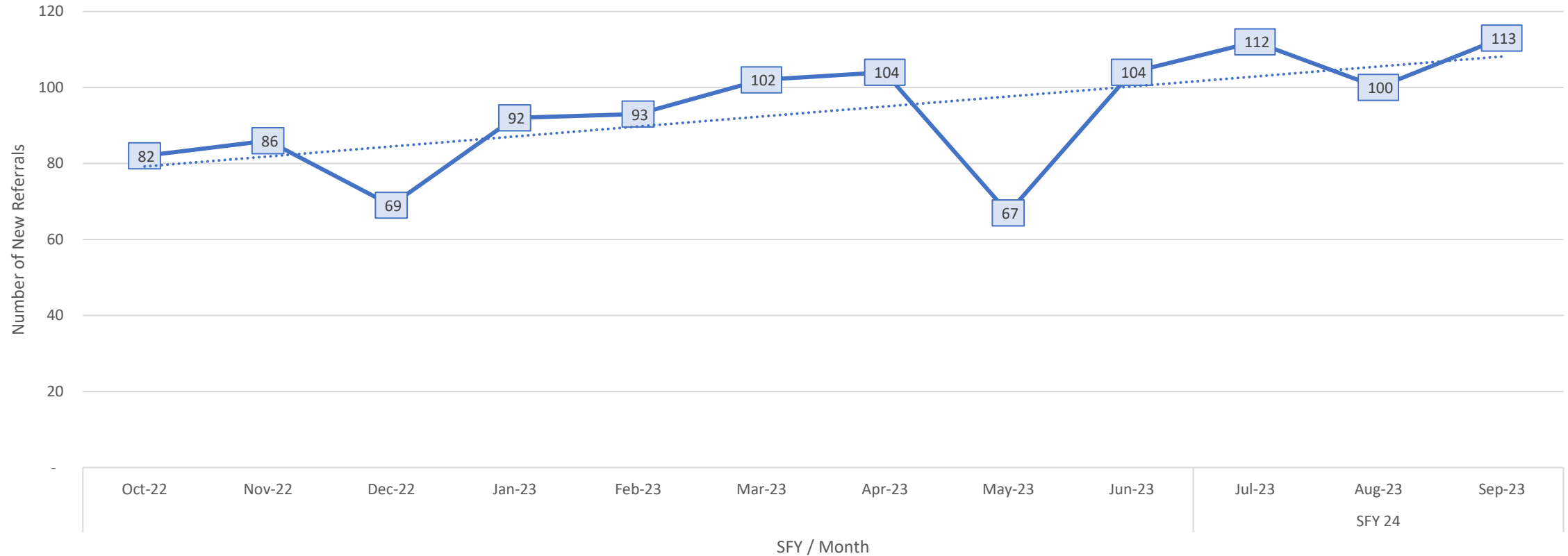

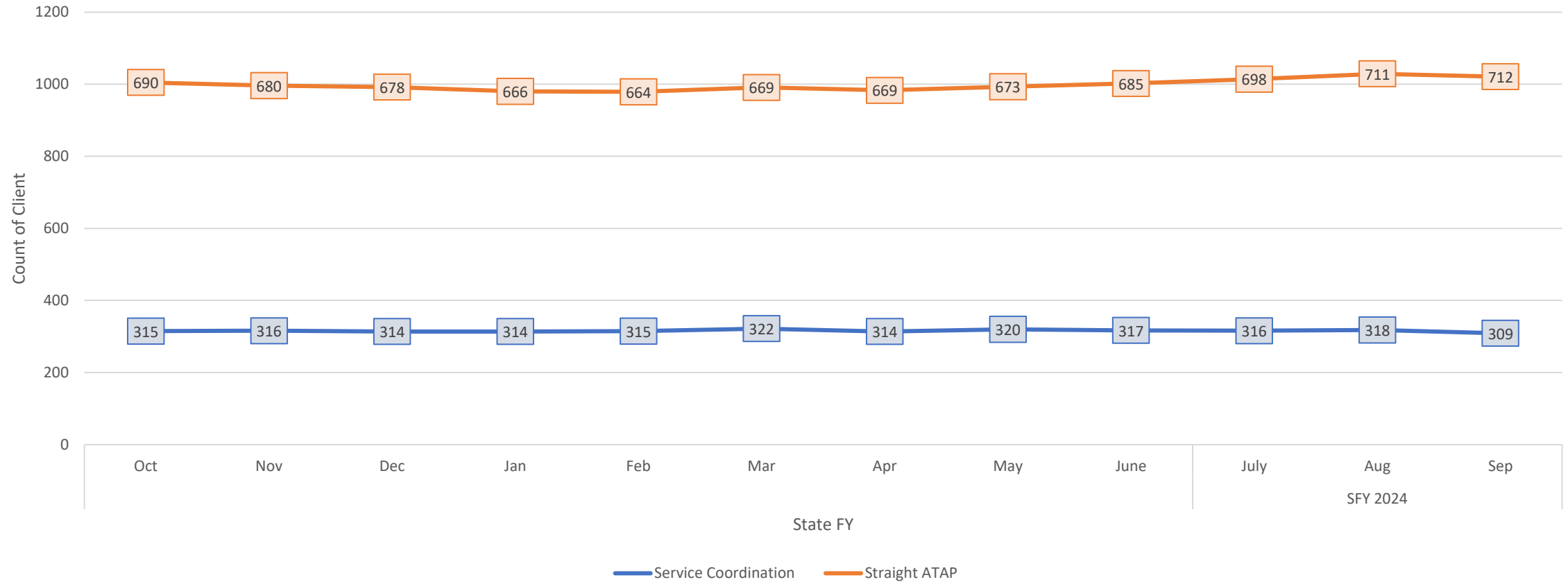


The chart above demonstrates the number of new referrals entering the ATAP system.

October 2022- September 2023

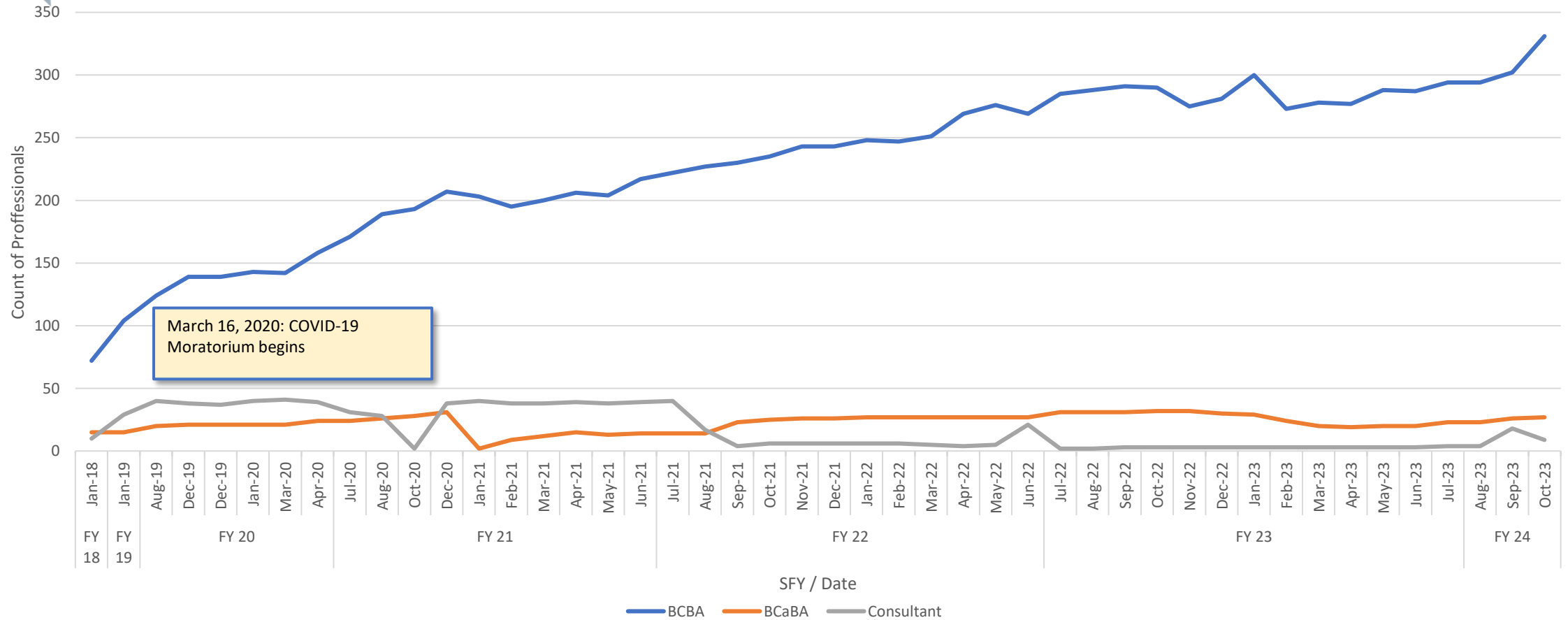


This chart shows the comparison between Straight ATAP and Medicaid Caseload (Service Coordination).

The chart above shows the trend in growth of professional service providers.

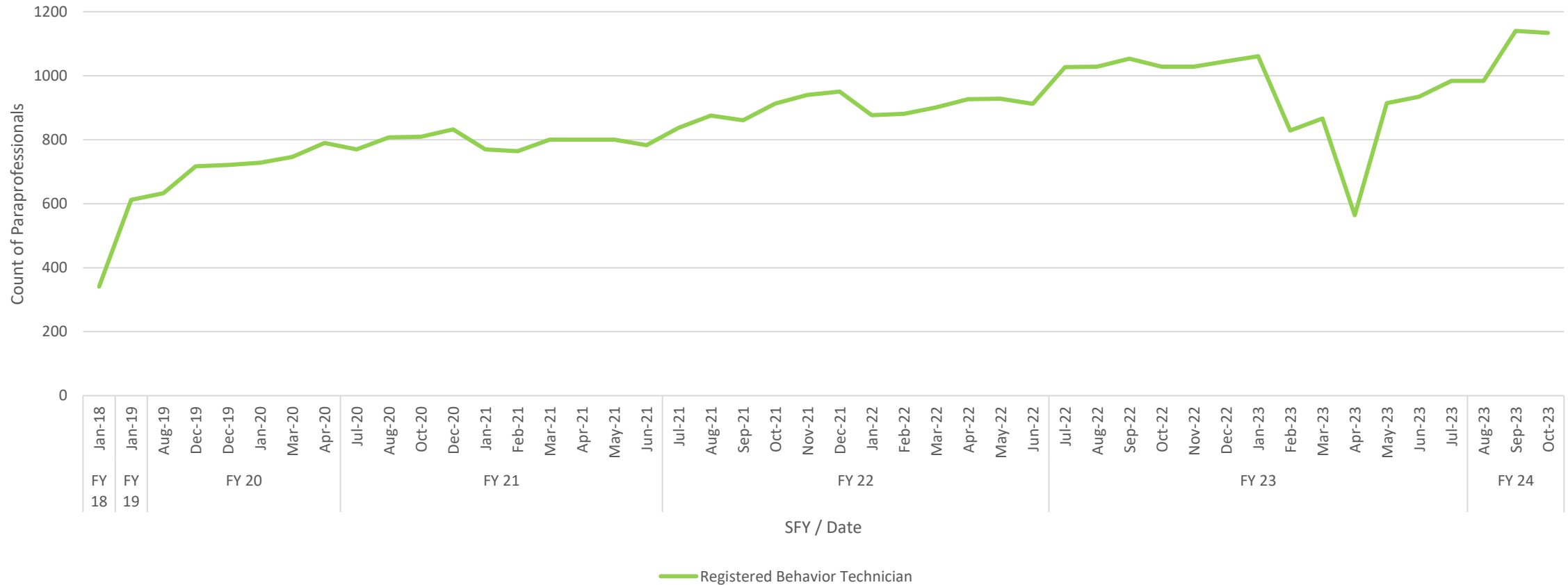
