Terminology

- Legislative Session- the 120-day convening (of the Legislature) to approve budgets for the biennium and make changes to NRS
- Legislature the collection of elected people (Legislators) that serve during the session. Compromised of two houses: Assembly and Senate
- Legislator an individual elected to represent a district in Nevada. People run for election either to the Assembly or the Senate



Terminology Cont.

- Bill- a proposed legislation under consideration by a legislature.
- BDR- Bill Draft Response is a request for the Legal Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau to draft a bill.
- NRS: (Nevada Revised Statue) the current codified laws of the State of Nevada
- NAC: (Nevada Administrative Code) the codified administrative regulations of the Executive Branch
- Nevada Register- a compilation of proposed, adopted, emergency and temporary administrative regulations, notices of intent and informational statements.







Branches of Government

The Senate is led by the President pro tempore and the Rules Committee Assembly is led by the Speaker.




Senate vs. Assembly

- 21 members
- Senate is set to be no less than one-third and no greater than one-half of the size of the Assembly
- 4-year terms, with 10 being elected in one General Election and 11 in the next.

- 42 members from singlemember districts
- 2-year terms at the general election held in even-numbered years.











Legislative Session

- Feb- May: Department and Division Budget Presentations
- Money committees hear budgets and make changes throughout session.
- Final budgets are approved by the end of the Legislature's 120-day session.
- The state constitution requires a balanced budget.
- Bills move through the Legislative process
- Statue Changes (fiscal or no fiscal impact)
- Appropriations



Interim Session

- The Interim Session begins in July after the regular session ends. (odd year)
- Interim Committees:
 - Hear about issues and needs of Nevadans
 - Assigned to research issues that came up during the regular session
 - Can sponsor Bill Draft Requests for next session
 - Individual Legislators also can sponsor BDRs
- August-September (even year): Committee Work Sessions


