Good afternoon, Director Erdoes,

I write today to request a Legislative Audit of the State's accessibility features. For example, I have been in communication with your Broadcast and Production Services (BPS) Manager concerning a recurring issue with NELIS' closed captioning (CC) feature.

However, this CC issue is just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to full accessibility and inclusion of people with disabilities in the People's process. For example, people who are deaf or hard of hearing may require American Sign Language (ASL) interpreters to fully participate in meetings. Additionally, people who are blind or have low vision may require meeting agendas in a non-PDF format. Lastly, people with hearing loss may require Communication Access Real Time (CART) transcription.

In summary, the Legislature, and the State as a whole, must do better when it comes to accessibility.
