### **Meeting Summary:**

We introduced our newest members Betty Hammond and Paula Koerwitz to our subcommittee. Discussed the most recent incident brought to our commission's attention of a State Welfare office not providing interpreter services and request a minor under the age of 10 to provide services for their parent. Ongoing complaints by providers about budgetary limitations. Ongoing recommendation is for providers to invest in on demand services on an iPad/tablet in office for D/HH signers' access just like audible language translation options by phone. Also, discussed the lack of an ADA Compliance officer in the state of Nevada and the ongoing problematic systemic challenges this presents for accountability to ADA Federal Law Compliance.

Creating a plan of action to help those with a hearing disability when a disaster strikes. Having Shelters with available accessibility.

Address the lack of resources in hospitals, doctor's offices, and emergency rooms. Advocate for better WiFi that can accommodate VRI in all Room for Healthcare Access.
