Meeting Summary: Multiple subcommittee members terms expiring after 2-years of service. A vote of the full commission is planned to modify bylaws to allow 3 years of service on subcommittees, so meeting continued. Discussion of SB203 from the 2019 legislative session led to a suggestion that the Commission seek a BDR for a legislative study of a state school for the Deaf, which was struck from SB203 before the rest of the bill was passed into law. A draft survey of students, families and educators was reviewed and approved to gain data helpful for educational advocacy efforts. Review of a recent job posting from Clark County School District led to a discussion of inadequate requirements for positions instructing Deaf children and a need for more dialog with districts and the Dept. of Education on the minimum skills required for educators.
