Education survey implementation discussed. David Kelsey to arrange for NSU interpreting students to provide video ASL interpretations of each survey question. Felicia Rutledge to develop a flyer we can circulate for promotion. ADSD will host on their server and provide the survey software platform.

In discussing the demise of AB247, the subcommittee agreed to support the legislative subcommittee in advancing the deaf school concept again in the next legislative session. Finally, the subcommittee voted to draft a letter to the Nevada Dept. of Education noting that we have been contacted by the national Lead-K movement and invited to participate in their meetings, but we need to understand what progress Nevada has made implementing the requirements of Lead-K (SB203).
