





Understanding the BDR Process

Community Issue Identification

Deaf community convenes to identify and reach consensus on critical issues requiring legislative or policy attention.

Stakeholder Engagement

Facilitate collaborative sessions with key stakeholders to develop comprehensive solution proposals for legislative consideration.

Task Force Formation

Establish dedicated task force comprising community leaders and subject matter experts to spearhead the initiative.

Strategic Relationship Building

Develop and nurture relationships with decision makers while raising awareness about Deaf community challenges and needs.

Solution Advocacy

Present compelling case for proposed solutions to key decision makers, emphasizing community impact and mplementation feasibility.




