WHAT IS RESPITE?

Respite is temporary relief for caregivers and families who are caring for those with disabilities, chronic or terminal illnesses, or the elderly.



BENEFITS OF RESPITE

Reduce STRESS

Giving a break to parents or caregivers – respite – has shown to reduce the risk of abuse or neglect of children with special needs

Could be the difference of a person remaining in their natural environment and being placed in an out-of-home care facility

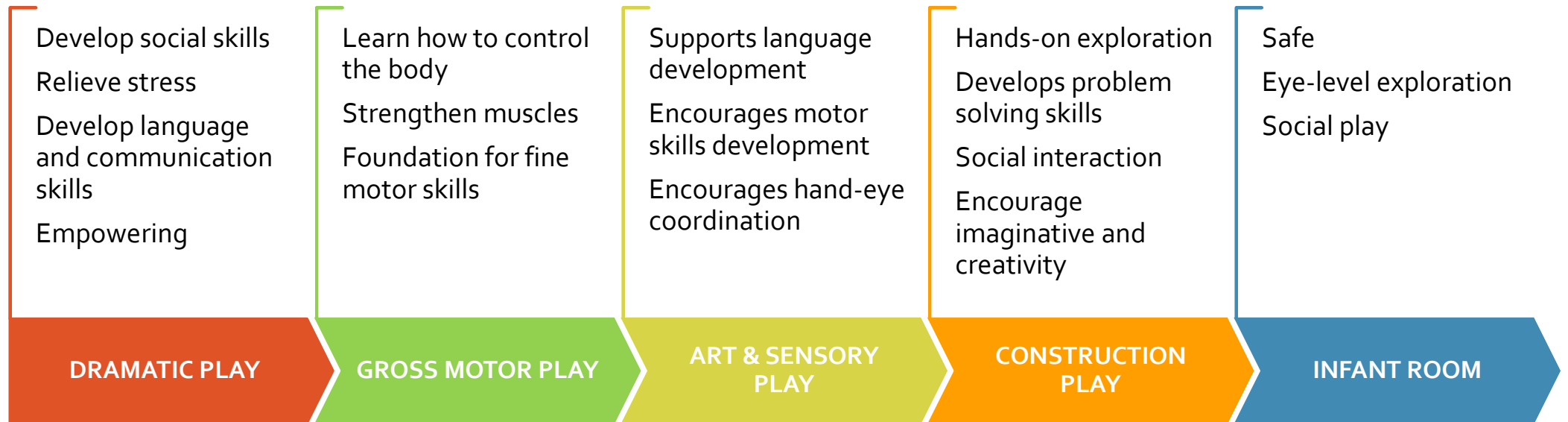
