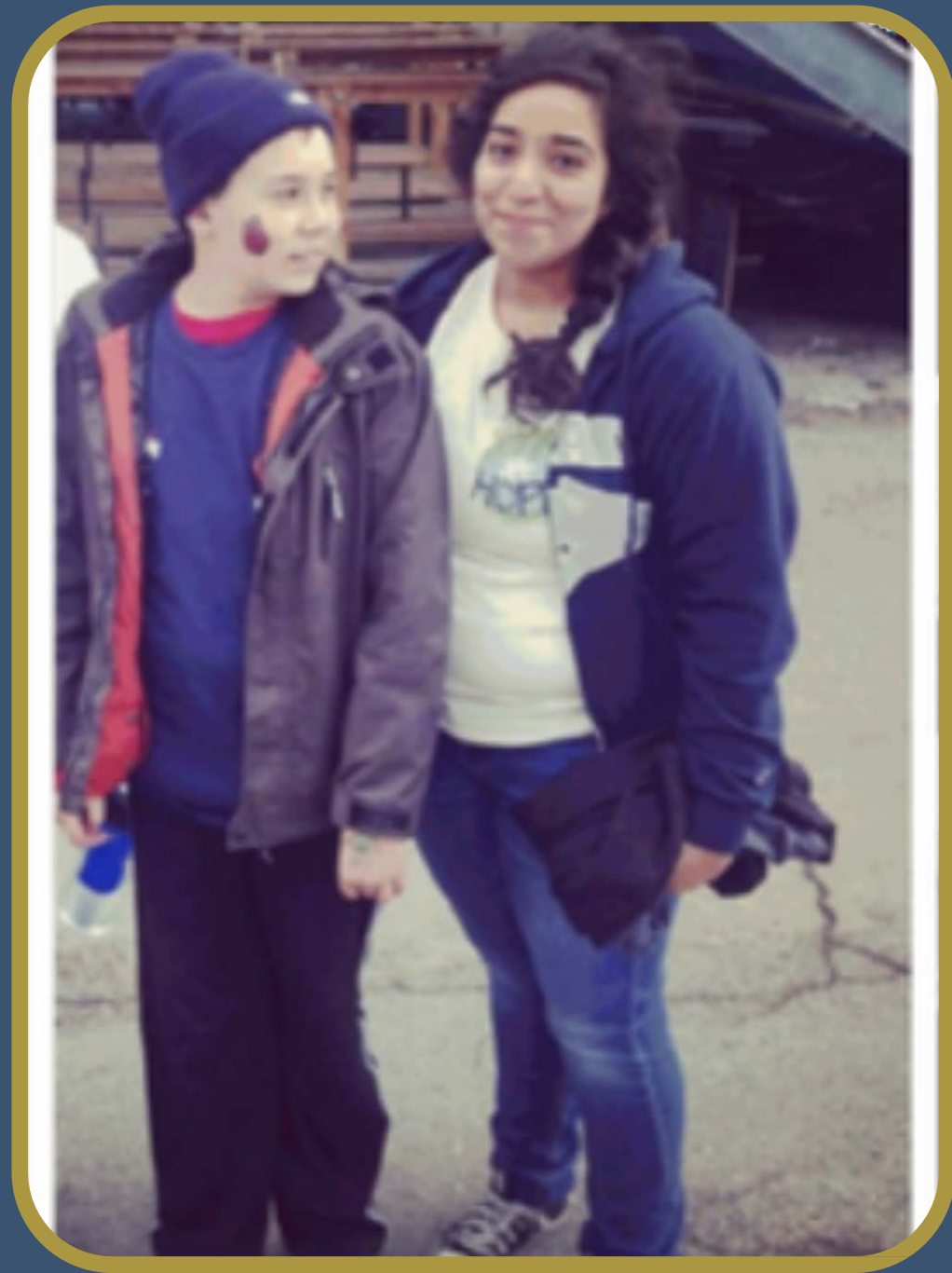
About US

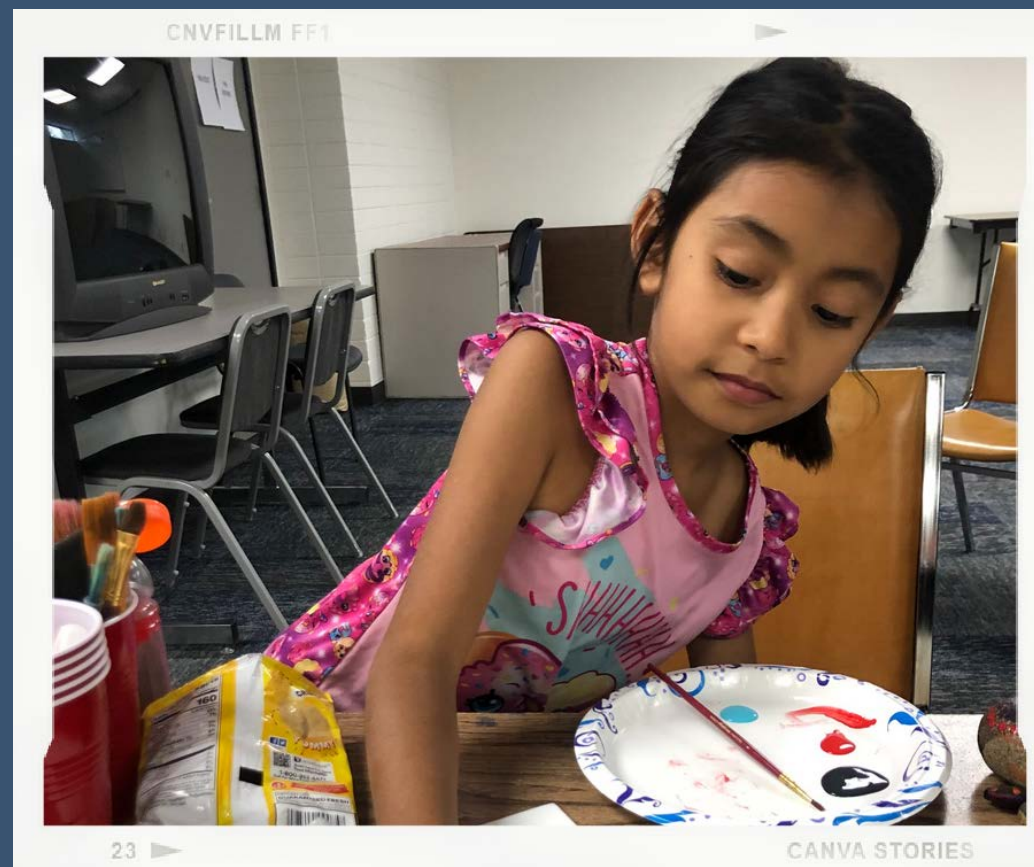
Have provided over 200 hours of in-home care to give caregivers a deserved break

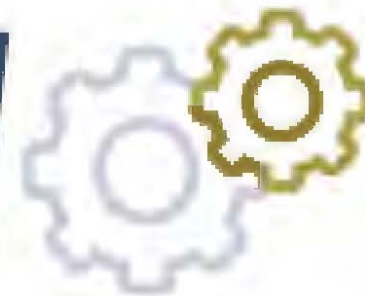

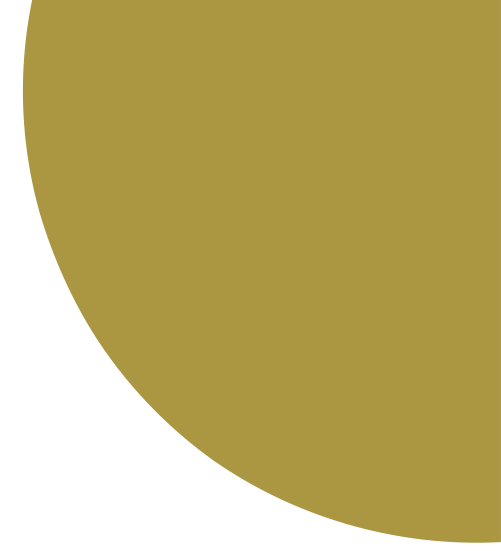




Unemployment Rates

The Bureau of Labor Statistics reported unemployment rates for eligible persons with IDD was 9.8% in 2018, more than twice the rate of those with no disability (3.7%).

Nationally, over 80% of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities are unemployed.

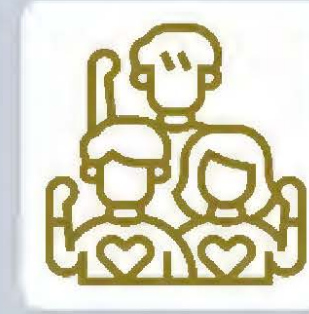
