Community Care

The <u>Community Care</u> program supports people 18 years of age and older who have intellectual and developmental disabilities, physical disabilities, dementia and related conditions, as well as their family care partners.

We do this by providing in-home and community-focused services that increase engagement by using a person/family-centered approach to care planning.





Community Care Services

Personal care Social, leisure & recreational activities Opportunities for civic engagement & self-advocacy **Transportation** Support accessing healthcare services, including routine wellness checks and vaccines Educational opportunities for people and their family members Respite care Home management Assistance with accessing community resources Comprehensive case management & care consultation





Respite Care Eligibility

- Respite care is to give the primary support person a break.
- Eligibility criteria for people to receive respite care is as follows:
 - Primary support person of a person who is 60+
 - Primary support person of a person (any age) who is living with dementia (or possible dementia) any age
 - Primary support person of a person with a disability who is 18+



What Respite Care Includes

- Minimum of 5 hours/week respite care plus comprehensive case management and care consultation
- Provided by trained, paid staff in the person's home and/or community
- People can choose who to hire, or N4 can recruit someone in the community to provide the respite care.
