 - Training requirements were approved in 2023. Requirements are specific to residential facilities for group/assisted living. These are the non-medical long-term care
 - Caregivers must receive 4 hrs. of tier 1 and 2 training within 60 days of hire.
 - 8 hrs. of training related to providing for the needs of residents to be completed within the second year, two hrs. of which must be of a tier 2 training.

- Facilities caring for people with Alzheimer's endorsements must complete two hrs. of tier two training within the first 40 hrs. of hire.
- An additional 8 hrs. of tier two training must be completed within 90 days of hire for a total of 10 hrs. of tier two training.
- An additional 3 hrs. of tier two training for those caring for residents with dementia that must be completed within the first year of employment.
