Licensed Psychologists provide psychological testing, evaluation, psychotherapy, counseling, and consultation to clients or inmates in residential, inpatient and outpatient settings, at a mental health, intellectual disabilities, or correctional facility, or in other settings where psychological services are provided. Incumbents possess a degree of knowledge and proficiency sufficient to perform advanced-level work and may provide work direction and training to others. Licensed Psychologist incumbents are to conduct psychological evaluations to inform eligibility decisions, perform psychological consultations and evaluations to assist in service planning for persons served by RRC. The incumbent will also provide training to RRC and direct support professional staff on topics relevant to service and delivery. The Licensed Psychologist will participate in RRC Eligibility Review Committee of applications for services and agency work groups and committees, as needed. Lastly, the incumbent must provide services online via telehealth technology and travel, including overnight throughout rural Nevada.
