POSITION DESCRIPTION

Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) is recruiting for multiple Public Service Intern 2 positions located at the Nevada Early Inter-vention Services Unit (NEIS) in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Under general supervision, Public Service Interns receive training and complete a variety of assignments in staff activities directly re-lating to their major course of study in order to enhance their academic training. Incumbents may be employed to intern in any profes-sional occupation in State service. This class may also be used when specific residency or practical experience is a requirement for certi-fication or registration.

This position is part time and is under the direction of a Developmental Specialist that provides specialized behavioral services and di-rect services to children under the age of three with disabilities (including but not limited to autism, vision and hearing impairments, genetics syndromes and prematurity) under the federal regulations of Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Bachelor's degree related to the field of employment and enrollment and continued successful perfor-mance in an academic graduate program related to the field of employment at an accredited college or university. (See Special Require-ments and Informational Notes). SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: • Some positions require a valid driver's license or evidence of equivalent mobility at the time of appointment and as a condition of continuing employment. • Pursuant to NRS 284.4066, some positions in this series have been identified as affecting public safety. Persons offered employment in these positions must submit to pre-employment screening for controlled substances. INFORMATIONAL NOTES: • Employment is not to exceed six months from the date of graduation. *Employment in this class will not lead to permanent status in state service.
