Social Worker I/II

Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) is recruiting for multiple Social Worker I/II positions in the following programs: Adult Protective Services (APS) and Community Based Care (CBC). Vacancies are located in Las Vegas, Reno, Carson City and Elko, Nevada.

Adult Protective Services:

APS Social Workers are responsible for assisting vulnerable adults, age 18 to 59, in addition to persons 60 years and older who are abused, neglected, exploited, isolated, or abandoned by investigating, providing, or arranging for services to alleviate and prevent further maltreatment while safeguarding their civil liberties. Social Workers complete visits in the community and long-term care facilities and document the investigations and interventions. Social Workers collaborate with community partners including Law Enforcement, Legal Services and Licensing Boards.

Community Based Care:

CBC Social Workers support Nevada's frail older adults and people with physical disabilities to remain independent in the community and prevent long term care placements. Case management is provided to program recipients to determine program eligibility, facilitate and monitor program services and connect to community resources. Person-centered contacts with the recipients are completed via telephone, face to face, and/or email to meet the health, safety, and welfare of program recipients.

Minimum Qualifications:

Licensure or provisional licensure as a Social Worker, Clinical Social Worker, Independent Social Worker or Associates in Social Work
