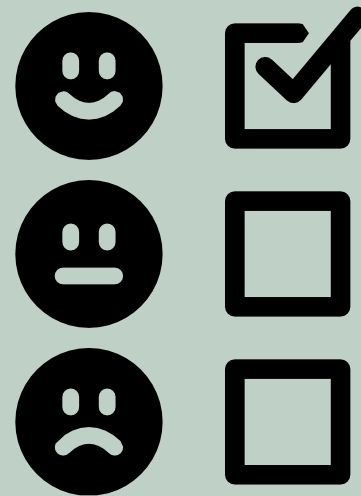
What do we want?

This survey gives you a chance to let us know what you think about your early intervention experience. Your service providers will not see your individual responses, so please be open and honest.



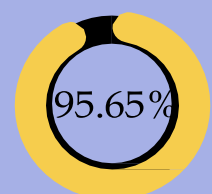
How can you help?



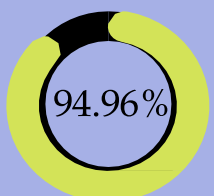

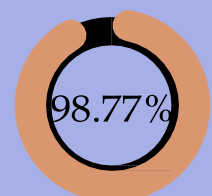
Results from 2025 Family Survey



95.65% of families who responded to the 2024 Family Survey agreed or strongly agreed that they **know their rights**.



94.96% of families that responded to the 2024 Family Survey agreed or strongly agreed that they **know how to effectively communicate their child's needs**.
