

Part B Child Find Data

SPP/APR:

Indicator 11: Child Find

- Percent of children who were evaluated within 60 days of receiving parental consent for initial evaluation (Nevada's timeline is 45 school days)
- Data is taken from State Monitoring, which is a 4-year cycle approved by Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP)
- Data is for all students not just students ages 3 – 5

Indicator 12: Early Childhood Transitions

- Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3, who are found eligible in Part B and who have an IEP developed and implemented by the student's 3rd birthday

Part B Application: application that Local Education Agency (LEA) applies for to receive their allotted federal funds

- District must include the following information:
 - Types of child identification awareness activities that have been used by the district (ex. Newspaper announcements, letter to parents in district, others)
 - List of agencies with whom communication and approximate number of contacts throughout the year (ex: Nevada Early Intervention Services – 5)
 - Total Number of individuals who received an initial special education evaluation throughout the district
