- Minimum 2 years of experience working with children with autism from 0-5 years old
- Hold a BCaBA Certification(Completion of Fieldwork, Pass Practicum) is recommended but not required
- Bilingual is a plus but not required
- Must have a Valid Driver's License and access to your own transportation

### Job Description:

- This position will require assisting in the development of behavioral plans, training other staff and families, and modeling strategies while working with the child throughout their natural routine.
- Responsible for providing evaluations and ongoing assessments as a member of a multi-disciplinary team.
- Demonstrate knowledge in a variety of evidence based treatment practices for children birth to 3 years old with autism or behavioral concerns.
- Providing or teaching resource materials and activities that remediate behavioral problems
- Develop and implement treatment programs to meet the individual needs of the child in natural environments.
- Responsible for completion of timely documentation including progress notes and reports.
- Communicate effectively with families, members of the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) team, and other health care providers regarding diagnosis and therapy.
