

# ADSD Non-Competitive Continuation

Notice of Funding Opportunity | FY2024

**Applications Due:** April 4, 2023

## General Information

The Aging and Disability Services Division is now accepting continuation applications from existing subrecipients for SFY2024 (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024).

The Division is expecting **flat funding** for the budget period. Subrecipients may request funding based on expected need in SFY 2024, however if the subrecipient requests an increase in funding, they should complete the Project Summary portion of the application to justify the request for an increase.

Funding for these services comes from a variety of state and federal sources including Older Americans Act, Funds for Healthy Nevada – Independent Living Grants, and Title XX. Final funding is subject to the availability of funds.

## Service Categories

The following Service Categories are being considered for this Non-Competitive Continuation funding. The service category is listed on your current Notice of Subaward.

- Ancillary Services
- Caregiver Support
- In-Home Services (including Homemaker)
- Food Security
- Health Promotion
- Transportation
- Access to Services

- Senior Community Services Employment Program
